The Rules made under the Council of Legal Education Incorporation Ordinance, as last amended by notification dated September 11, 1971, and published in the “Ceylon Government Gazette” No. 14,984 dated November 12, 1971, were further amended at the meetings of the Council of Legal Education held on November 5, 1971, June 9, 1972, August 3, 1972, October 20, 1972 and December 19, 1972, as follows:—

- (a) Rule 13 by re-numbering the existing clause as (1) and by adding a new clause, “(2) The Council shall also, on the recommendation of the Board of Studies, make suitable provision for tutorial classes in specified subjects.”
- (b) Rule 21 by the addition between the word “course” and the word “and” in line 2 of the following words:—
