THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE

RULES made by the Minister of Posts and Telecommunications under section 13 of the Telecommunications Ordinance (Chapter 192).

The Indo-Sri Lanka Telephone Rules

1. These rules may be cited as the Indo-Sri Lanka Telephone Rules.

2. (1) The first unit period of conversation of an Indo-Sri Lanka telephone call shall be three minutes chargeable time and the second and subsequent unit periods shall be one minute chargeable times each, and for this purpose any interval of more than five seconds and less than sixty seconds chargeable time shall be reckoned as one minute.

(2) There shall be no prescribed maximum period for any one call; Provided however, that in case of pressure, calls may be limited to the first unit period of three minutes.

(3) No caller shall be entitled to engage the trunk line for more than one call at a time to the exclusion of any other caller who may desire to use the trunk lines or any portion thereof.

(4) Where the duration of the call is limited, the caller shall be so informed, if possible at the time when the call is about to be connected, the caller and the called person shall also, if possible be so advised a few seconds before the disconnection of the call.

3. (1) An Indo-Sri Lanka telephone call may be booked either—

- (a) as an ordinary call, that is to say, a call from any specified number to another specified number only, the calling and the called numbers being recorded, or
- (b) as a personal call, that is to say, a call from a specified person at the calling number to a specified person at the called number.

(2) A caller booking a personal call shall have the option of naming a substitute for himself and a substitute for the specified person at the called number or at any other number specified as an alternative. The call shall be treated as effective if either of the named persons is obtained at either of the numbers given.

(3) In the case of an ordinary call, the first unit period of conversation shall be deemed to commence at the moment when the calling number is placed in communication with the called number, and in the case of the personal call, at the moment when the caller or his substitute is placed in communication with the called person or that person's substitute.

(4) All call bookings shall remain valid so long as they have not been connected, refused by the called person or cancelled by the caller.

4. (1) In the case of a personal call to—

- (a) if the number or particular person called refuses a trunk connection after being rung up, the charge provided for an ordinary call of three minutes duration shall be made against the caller,
- (b) if the call is abandoned after communication has been established with the called number, and the caller or failing him, someone at his telephone is notified that neither the called person nor that person's substitute is available to speak, a report charge shall be levied.
- (c) if at the time when the call is ready to mature with the called number, the caller or the called person is not available, or is unwilling to speak, or there is no reply from the caller or called person's telephone and the call is cancelled, or
- (d) if the called person is not a telephone subscriber and arrangements have been made for him to come to a specified telephone number and communication is not established owing to failure to ensure his presence at such telephone number, or the call is cancelled before he comes, report charge shall be levied.

(2) The decision of the Director of Telecommunications as to when a report charge is payable shall be final.

5. No charge shall be made in the following cases—

- (a) When the called line or calling line after booking a call gets out of order.
- (b) When a called number has been disconnected.
- (c) When there is no answer from the called number.
- (d) When the call is cancelled after it has been passed to the controlling exchange in India and before the attention of the called subscriber has been obtained.

6. (1) In the case of a call made from a call office, the period of conversation required shall in every case be booked in advance, and no extension shall be given, at the end of such period at the request of the caller unless he has already deposited the appropriate fee for a further period of conversation, and where a caller terminates his conversation before the full period so booked by him expires, he shall be charged for the actual period of effective conversation he has had or for the first unit period of effective conversation, whichever of these is the longer.

(2) In the case of a call made from a call office, there shall be no call office fee and the charges due on the call shall be prepaid. Provided, however that, where the controlling exchange is not in a position to quote in advance the actual charge payable, the caller shall be required to deposit any reasonable sum, and any difference between such deposit and the actual charges due from him shall be paid or recovered by him, as the case may be, at the conclusion of the call.

7. No Indian trunk call originating from a subscriber's own telephone shall be put through unless the subscriber has deposited with the Post Office exchange with which his telephone is connected—

- (a) in the first instance the sum of Rs. 150 as security for Indian and Overseas calls, and
- (b) if at any time, the average amount due from the subscriber in respect of the two weeks' Indian and Overseas trunk calls exceed Rs. 150 an amount equal to that average.

8. Bills on account of Indian trunk calls will be rendered weekly and subscriber shall settle them in full within seven days, in default of which Indian and Overseas trunk call facilities shall be withdrawn without further notice. Inland trunk facilities may also be withdrawn until any outstanding Indian Trunk account is settled, in addition to any other steps the Postmaster General may take under the relevant conditions in the Telephone agreement.

9. The fee to be charged for a telephone trunk call to India shall be determined by the Postmaster General and Director of Telecommunication and notified from time to time in the Post Office Circular.

10. (1) The disturbance fee prescribed in Rule 10 of the Inland Telephone Rules, published in *Gazette* No. 8,360 of March 25, 1938, shall be payable on every trunk call to India made from and through any Exchange or call office in Sri Lanka which is closed during any part of the working period of the Indo-Sri Lanka Telephone Service.

(2) No disturbance fee shall be payable on any call referred to paragraph (1) where only a Report Charge is due, or when a call is ineffective owing to service or other reasons.

11. The Indo-Ceylon Telephone Rules published in *Gazette* No. 1,812 of March 29, 1935, as subsequently amended, are hereby rescinded.

12. The rules published in the Supplement to *Gazette* No. 8,198 of January 24, 1936, and therein called "The Ceylon Telegraph Rules (Inland and Indo-Ceylon)" as amended from time to time, are hereby further amended, as follows:—

By the substitution for "Chapter III, Indo-Ceylon Telegram Rules, (Rules 189 to 205 both inclusive) of the following new Chapter:—

CHAPTER III

INDO-(CEYLON) SRI LANKA TELEGRAM RULES

189. *General.*—The conditions, restrictions, rates and other matters set out in the Foreign and Radio Telegraph Rules, 1937, shall apply to Indo-Ceylon Telegrams subject to the following modifications:—

190. *Classes of Telegrams.*—The following classes of Telegrams shall be accepted for transmission:—

- (a) Telegrams relating to safety of life (Class prefix: SVH).
- (b) Government Telegrams (Including telegrams relating to the application of the United Nations charter). (Class prefix: XFS).
- (c) Meteorological Telegrams: (Class prefix: OBS).
- (d) Telegrams concerning persons protected in time of war by the Geneva Convention of 12th August, 1949. (Same class prefix as for private telegrams with paid special indication "RCT" before the address).
- (e) Private telegrams (Ordinary, Class prefix: XF Urgent, Class prefix XXF).
- (f) Press Telegrams: (Ordinary, Class prefix: Z. Urgent class prefix XZ).
- (g) Service telegrams and service advices. (Class prefixes: T, XT, XXT).
- (h) Paid service advices. (Class prefixes: FST, RST).

Note.—Letter telegrams and Commonwealth Social Telegrams shall not be accepted for transmission.

191. *Special Services.*—The following special services shall be available:—

- (a) Urgent transmission and delivery (Paid indication before the address: URGENT).
- (b) Collation (Paid indication before the address: TC).
- (c) Prepaid Reply (Paid indication before the address: RPX).
- (d) Confirmation of delivery (Paid indication before the address: PC).
- (e) Re-forwarding at the sender's request: (Paid indication before the address: FS).
- (f) Multiple addresses. (Paid indication before the address: TMX).
- (g) Redirection at the addressee's request.
- (h) Express delivery. (Paid indication before the address: EP/Express).
- (i) Delivery by Post or Air-Mail, Ordinary or Registered. (Paid indication before the address: POSTE/PAV/PR/PAVR).

192. *Charges.*—The charges for Indo-Sri Lanka telegrams shall be published in the Ceylon Post Office Guide.

193. *Charges for special service.*—mentioned in rule 191 shall be as prescribed in the Foreign and Radio Telegraph Rules, 1937.

194. *Refunds.*—The period of twenty-four hours specified in rule 165 (1) (b) and (c) shall not be applicable to Indo-Sri Lanka telegrams. A refund in any such shall be made only to the extent a refund is permitted by the Indian Telegraph Rules.

195. *Repeals.*—The following Rules are hereby repealed:—

- (i) Rule 1 to 127 of the rules for the conduct of telegraphs published in the Supplement to the *Gazette* of August 27, 1909, as last amended by notification published in *Gazette* of December 15, 1933.
- (ii) The rules governing the exchange of telegrams between Ceylon and India published by notification in the *Gazette* of November 3, 1922, as amended by notification published in *Gazette* of October 18, 1929.
