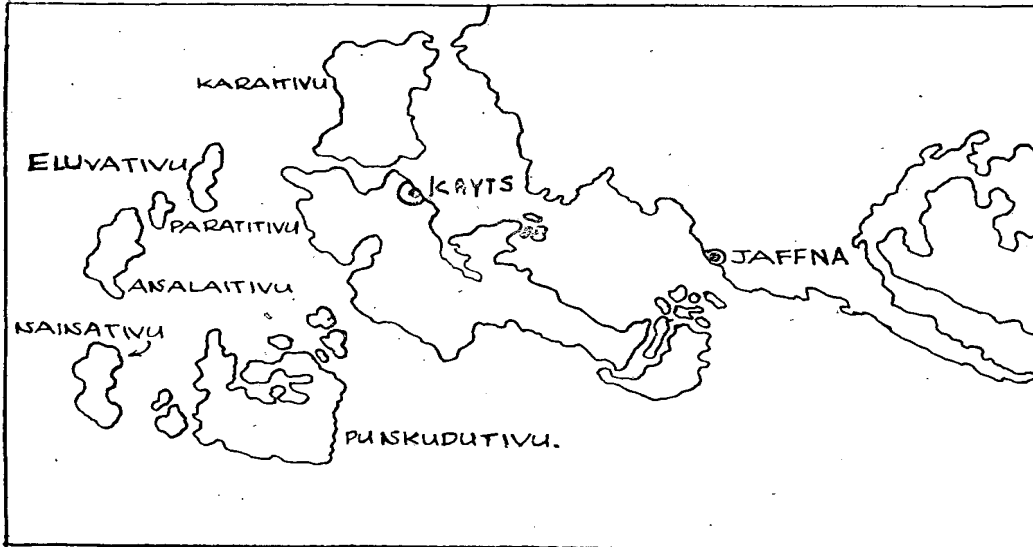

The Honourable Minister of Labour has, by virtue of the powers vested in him under section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (Revised Edition 1956), referred to this Tribunal for settlement by arbitration the industrial dispute existing between Mr. R. A. Piyasena of Nugegoda, and the Associated Tea Estates of Ceylon Ltd. (Proprietors of Doragolla Estate, Pussellawa). According to the statement which accompanied the reference the matter in dispute between them is whether the termination of the employment of Mr. R. A. Piyasena is justified, and to what relief he is entitled.

At the inquiry Mr. A. M. Yousoof, Advocate, instructed by Mr. A. H. M. Jameel appeared for the Applicant, and Mr. D. C. Amerasinghe, Advocate, instructed by Messrs. F. J. & G. de Saram appeared for the respondent.

When this matter was taken up for inquiry on 27.3.73, Mr. Amerasinghe for the respondent offered to pay a sum of Rs. 4,000 to the workman as an *ex gratia* payment in full and final satisfaction of all claims arising out of the termination of his services, inclusive of statutory and other payments. The workman accepted this offer and agreed to draw payment in open Tribunal on 9.4.73.

I consider this settlement just and equitable, and make order against the respondent directing that a sum of Rs. 4,000 be paid to the workman in open Tribunal on 9.4.73.
