### Posts - Vacant

GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA (CEYLON)"

- 1. Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowances and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.
- 2. Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.
- 3. Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute at their option a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution in either case will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.
- (ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.
- (iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.
- 4. New Entrants to the Public Service.—(i) The period of probation/trial of New-Entrant Officers

- appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be three years, unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.
- (ii) All New-Entrant Officers must subscribe to the condition that they will conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956 and any laws and rules that now exists or may be introduced in the future for giving effect to the language Policy of the Government.
- (iii) (a) They should acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language (Sinhala) during their period of probation/trial except in exceptional cases where it is not essential for the efficient discharge of their duties.
- (b) Their confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation/trial, will depend inter alia, on their passing within specified periods of time prescribed proficiency tests in Sinhala leading up to a level not higher than the J. S. C. Standard. Failure to pass these proficiency tests within the prescribed period will result in the non-payment of the increments falling due, until the tests are passed. The services of those officers who do not reach the requisite standard of proficiency in Sinhala by the end of their period of probation/trial will be liable to be terminated.

Note.—Those who qualify for entry into the Public Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempted from passing these proficiency tests in Sinhala as a pre-requisite for confirmation.

- 5. Qualifications Required.—(i) Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.
- (ii) A Candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate examination or equivalent or higher examination shall have a pass in the Sinhala Language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. - 6. War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord) will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3. 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone provided that they joined the Forces, before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

One Year Internal Post Graduate Course for the Diploma in Education—1974 at the University of Sri Lanka and the Two Year Postal Post Graduate Course for the Diploma in Education

APPLICATIONS are invited from following teachers to follow the above course for the Diploma in Education at the University of Sri Lanka:—

- (i) Graduate teachers in service in Government Schools and Guru Vidyalayas.
- (ii) Graduate teachers in service in Government Technical Education Institutes (This category of teachers will be recruited for the Two Years Postal Course).
- (iii) Graduate officers in the Ceylon Education Service.
- 2. The Internal Course for this Diploma is of one year's duration and the Postal Course is of two years' duration.
- 3. Method of forwarding applications.—(a) Applications which should be according to the specimen given below should be sent under registered cover to the Director of Education, Teacher Education Branch, Ministry of Education, Malay Street, Colombo 2, to reach him on or before 12th July, 1973.

(ii) possesses 10 years of teaching service of which at least 3 years should be teaching experience as a graduate Teacher on the Graduate scale of salary in a Government School or in a Government Guru Vidyalaya or in a Government Technical Education institute on 12th July, 1973.

Note.—(i) Service as a member of the eligible staff of a recognised private school, whose appointments have been approved by the Regional Director of Education or Chief Education Officer will also be recognised in computing the experience. For this purpose, Assisted Schools which became fee-levying in 1951 and schools which became private non-fee-levying on 1.12.1960, are regarded as recognised private schools.

- (ii) Graduates of recognised Universities, with the Pracheena Pundits Certificate and who were placed on the Graduate scale of salary on the Pracheena Pundits Certificates will be allowed to count the teaching experience required here in computing their service from the date they were placed on the Graduate Scale of salary;
  - (e) possesses a good knowledge of Sinnala/Tamil/ English;
  - (f) Teachers who have entered into a bond for the purpose of obtaining study leave will be eligible to apply for the one Year Internal Course only if they have completed at least 5 years of obligatory service under the bond on 12th July, 1973. Applications of those who have not completed the requisite service will be rejected.
  - 5. If it is found, at any time before or after the Selection Test, that a candidate does not have the necessary qualifications according to the Gazette Notification, his/her application will be rejected and the

candidature will be cancelled. Teachers whose work, conduct and attendance is found to be unsatisfactory at any time during the period of the course will be discontinued from the course.

6. The selection will be by a written examination and an interview. The written examination will be held on 25.8.73, by the Commissioner of Examinations.

Subjects for the examination will be-

- (i) General information and knowledge of current affairs; Information and knowledge of educational problems.
- (ii) General Intelligence.
- 7. The written test for selection to this course will be conducted in all three media viz. Sinhala, Tamil and English but for those selected, this course will be available only in Sinhala and Tamil media.
- 8. Agreement.—Selected candidates for the One Year Internal Course will be required to enter into a bond and agreement with the Regional Director of Education/Chief Education Officer to serve the Department for a minimum period of 5 years on the successful completion of the course. However, when the cost of training is more than Rs. 10,000 the period of obligatory service under the bond will be determined in terms of rules in the Establishment code—Government of Ceylon.
- 9. Any candidate who follows the Internal Course and fails to obtain the Diploma during the specified period should refund to the Government the full amount paid to him or her as salary and allowances during the period of study leave.
- 10. Study Leave.—Selected candidates for the One Year Internal Course for this Diploma will be granted full pay study leave.
