Award

This is an Industrial Dispute between the Ceylon Estates Staff Union (hereinafter referred to as the Union), and Mr. G. P. D. Jinadasa, Proprietor, Handford Estate, Deniyaya. (hereinafter referred to as the employer). The above dispute was referred to this Tribunal for settlement by arbitration by an order made by Hon. the Minister of Labour, under the provision of Section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act (Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon Revised Edition 1956), as amended. The matter in dispute between the parties, according to the statement of the Commissioner of Labour, appended to the reference is—

- (1) Whether Mr. D. M. L. Dissanayake was the conductor of Handford Estate from December, 1965, to August, 1967, performing the duties coming within the purview of an Estate Conductor;
- (2) Whether an Award should be made in favour of Mr. D. M. L. Dissanayake, by way of underpayments in a sum of Rs. 4,449.70, that would accrue to him in terms of Collective Agreement No. 4 of 1965, and to what relief he is entitled to.

This matter had first been taken up for hearing on 07.05.72, before my predecessor in office. On this date, Mr. Isidore Fernando, appeared on behalf of the employer, whilst Mr. E. R. Wijeratne represented the Union. Subsequently when it came up for hearing before me on 27.01.73, and again on 02.04.73, Mr. P. W. Panditha appeared on behalf of the Employer and Mr. E. R. Wijeratne, represented the Union. On 27.01.73, parties moved to adopt the proceedings had before this Tribunal and moved that an order be made on the submissions made by the counsel for the respondent on 08.05.72. On this date, Mr. Panditha, made further submissions and the Union was given time to file counter submissions within three weeks. The written submissions were received in the Tribunal on 01.03.73. On my finding that the document marked 'A' 1 by the Union, was not in fact the document which was intended to be so marked, this matter had to be called again on 02.04.73, in order to get that error rectified.

This matter had proceeded to inquiry and evidence of the Workman recorded. When Mr. Fernando, submitted that the matter before the Tribunal is, whether the Workman was a conductor on Hanford Estate from December, 1955, to 31st August, 1967, and whether he is entitled to the claim of Rs. 4,449.70, by way of underpayments in terms of the Collective Agreement No. 4 of 1965. He submitted that even if the workman had been a Field Officer, during the period referred to above, he would be entitled to the basic salary of Rs. 65 per month, rising to Rs. 70 per month, plus allowances with annual increments, and he would have been then entitled to a salary of Rs. 65 plus Rs. 74.55, and a further living allowances of Rs. 5. When the management had paid the workman a monthly salary of Rs. 250, he had in fact been overpaid, and in this circumstance no payment is due to him as arrears of salary. He also submitted that paras. 5, 7 and 10, of the Collective Agreement did not apply to the workman's probationary period. According to the Collective Agreement it is only after the completion of two years service in a grade on a salary of Rs. 35 per month, (first appointment) he shall be entitled to appointment to a grade in accordance with clause 4 of the Collective Agreement.

The Union in its counter submissions filed on 30.06.72, took up the position that the worker concerned is one who had more than two years service to his credit, and he was entitled to the terms and conditions set out in Clause 4 of the Collective Agreement 4 of 1965, when he took up appointment as conductor on Hanford Estate.

The workman giving evidence before this Tribunal stated that he was first employed by the Respondent at Galwatawatte in Rakwana, on 14.06.65, there he was paid Rs. 200 per month. He further stated that he was subsequently transferred to

Hanford Estate at Deniyaya, with effect from 02.12.65, and that he was paid Rs. 250 a month, on the latter estate. It is also in evidence that before the workman came to be employed under the Respondent, he was employed at the Tea Research Institute at Ratnapura, as a Creeper, which, according to workman himself, had been a period of training. In answer to a question in cross-examination, the workman stated that he was appointed a Field Officer, for the first time on 01.07.65. Although, he stated that he did not know that his appointment at Hanford Estate was subject to a probationary period, till March, 1966, in answer to a further question he admitted that after a probationary period he was confirmed on 01.04.66. It appears therefore, that the workman was a probationer and a new entrant in terms of Clause 2 (A) of the Collective Agreement at the time he was appointed by the Respondent.

I agree with the submissions made by the Counsel for the Respondent that the workman was not entitled to the grading as provided for in Clause 4 at the time of commencement of his employment. I also hold that the workman was entitled to receive an allowance of Rs. 100 per month, for the period from 14.06.65, to 28.02.66, and from 01.03.66, up to two years, he was only entitled to be allocated to the intermediate grade on a salary scale of Rs. 65—5 × 1—Rs. 70 per month, plus allowances as in Schedule 'B', and after completion of two years in the intermediate grade only that he was entitled to be allocated to a grade in accordance with the provisions of Clause 4. Therefore, for the period 01.03.66, to 28.02.67, he was entitled to receive a salary of Rs. 65 plus allowances, and from 01.04.67, he should have received a basic salary of Rs. 70 per month. In the final analysis, it appears that the workman had been overpaid in an amount of approximately Rs. 100 per month.

The Counsel for the Respondent also submitted that the amount of Rs. 4,449.70, alleged to be due to the workman on account of balance wages and payments due for work done on non-working days and on account of overtime work are all statutory dues under the Wages Board Ordinance. He cited Section 64 of the Wages Boards Ordinance as amended by Act, No. 27 of 1962, according to the definition of "Wages" given therein.

"Wages includes any remuneration due in respect of overtime work done on holidays".

He also submitted that according to Section 8 of the Industrial Disputes Act, every Collective Agreement shall be binding on the parties and the terms of agreement shall be implied terms in the contract of employment between the employer and the workman bound by the Agreement. He submitted that in terms of Section 56 (e) of the Wages Boards Ordinance, recovery of any sum due under this Ordinance, from any employer shall be made within four years after that sum had become due. Therefore, the claim for relief under the Wages Boards Ordinance is time-barred. I am in agreement with the above submissions.

Even if the first matter under reference is answered in the affirmative, in view of the conclusions I have arrived at, and as stated above, the workman is not entitled to the arrears of balance wages claimed in terms of the Collective Agreement No. 4 of 1965, workman having been entitled only to be placed on the salary scale of Rs. 65—5 × 1—Rs. 70, for the entire period of his employment under the Respondent from 01.04.66, the date of his confirmation after his probationary period.

The claim in regard to balance wages and also on account of overtime payments in respect of work done on non-working days too, cannot be maintained as they are statutory under the Wages Boards Ordinance and therefore demedy should have been sought within four years from the date on which they became due.

I do not think it necessary to deal with the further submissions made by Mr. Panditha on 29.01.73, taking up the position that provisions of the Collective Agreement No. 4 of 1965, would only be applicable to members of the Ceylon Estates Staff Union at the time the said Collective Agreement was entered into, in view of conclusions I have arrived at on the other submissions, made on behalf of the employer.

I hold that the workman is not entitled to any relief. I make Award accordingly.

- revoke with immediate effect, Food and Price Order No. KD/147 dated April 18, 1973 and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 61 dated 25th May, 1973.
- fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 148 lbs. nett, above which Wheat Flour shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column I of the same Schedule ;
- fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per pound nett above which wheat flour shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column I of the same Schedule ;
- direct for the purpose of this Order—
  - any sale of any quantity of wheat flour for the purpose of resale or any sale of wheat flour in a quantity of one hundred weight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
  - any sale of any quantity of wheat flour less than one hundred weight nett shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
  - " wheat flour " shall be deemed to include any mixture of wheat flour with maize flour ;
- direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell wheat flour which is adulterated with any other article except maize flour ;
- direct that no person shall sell any mixture of wheat flour and maize flour which contains more than ten percent by weight of maize flour ;
- direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, any trader who has any wheat flour in his possession or under his control at any place or any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of the wheat flour in a suitable container with the maximum prices of the wheat flour fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or board attached to such container in such a manner that the wheat flour and the maximum prices could clearly be seen by any customer ;
- direct that for the purpose of this Order " pound " or " lb. " shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight ;
- direct that the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of wheat flour which is less than or more than 148 lbs. nett and sold by wholesale should be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per 148 lbs. nett ;

- (x) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells wheat flour by wholesale shall, or by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) date of sale ;
  - (b) the quantity of wheat flour sold (by weight) ;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold ; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
- (xi) direct that when any wheat flour is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such wheat flour is sold.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Muthu Bandara Ranasinghe, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta Divisional Revenue Officer's Division in Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with immediate effect Food and Price Order No. KD/146 dated 18th April, 1973 and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 61 dated 25th May, 1973;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices above which bread shall not be sold in 16 ozs. loaves and 8 ozs. loaves respectively within the area specified in the corresponding entry in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto ;
- (iii) direct that any loaf weighing more than 8 ozs. or any part more than 8 ozs. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 16 ozs. loaf fixed by this Order for that area ;
- (iv) direct that any loaf weighing not more than 8 ozs. or any part not more than 8 ozs. in weight of any loaf shall not be sold in any area at a price higher than the price calculated proportionately by weight from the maximum price per 8 ozs. loaf fixed by this Order for that area ;
- (v) direct that when any bread is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such bread is sold ;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has bread in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of Bread ;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any bread shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) date of sale ;
  - (b) description of the loaf or loaves of bread sold ;
  - (c) the quantity of bread sold ; and
  - (d) the price paid for the bread sold.
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order " ozs. " shall be deemed to be the standard ounce " avoirdupois " weight.
