APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS IN THE STATE SERVICE GENERAL CONDITIONS ADVERTISED IN THE "GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA (CEYLON)"

1. General Qualifications required

- 1:1 Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration as defined in the Ceylon Citizenship Act.
- 1:2 A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination should have a pass in the Sinhala Language obtained at the Senior School Certificate Examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. (This requirement will not apply to those who are in the State Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961, and who seek appointments to other posts in the State Service).
- 1:3 Applications from the 'New public officers whose probationary/trial appointments have been terminated for failure to pass the prescribed Proficiency Test in Sinhala will not be entertained unless they have obtained the qualifications which would entitle them to seek exemptions from the highest Proficiency Test in Sinhala prescribed for the post or service in terms of Treasury Circular No. 640.

2. Allowances

2:1 In addition to the monthly consolidated salary applicable to the post, all monthly paid married officers in the State Service will be paid a Married Allowance on the basis set out in Section 1 of Chapter VIII of the Establishments Code.

2:2 Monthly paid State Officers in the salary/ wage group ranging from Rs. 180 to Rs. 250 per month (inclusive of all allowances), will be paid a Special Allowance of Rs. 7.50 per mensem subject to any adjustments where necessary.

3. Conditions of Service: General

- 3:1 All officers in the State Service will be subject to the Financial Regulations, the Establishments Code, Departmental Orders or Regulations and any offer Orders or Regulations that may be issued by Government from time to
- 3:2 A State Officer may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, in such sum and in such manner as the Secretary to the Ministry concerned may determine.
- 3:3 A State Officer may be called upon to serve in any part of the Island.

4. Conditions of Service applicable to State Officers holding permanent appointments

- 4:1 In addition to the conditions referred to in Section 3 above, State Officers holding permanent appointments will be subject to the following further conditions:-
- 4:1:1 All appointments will be on probation for a period of 3 years unless a longer period is considered necessary in respect of any post. An appointment may be terminated at any time during the period of probation without a reason being assigned. being assigned.

- 4:1:2 All State Officers who are "New Entrants" to the State Service, for purposes of the official language policy of the State are required to conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any laws and rules that now exist or may be introduced in the future to give effect to the language policy of the State.
- 4:1:3 All State Officers are required to acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language during their period of probation.
- 4:1:4 Confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation will depend, inter alia, on the passing of the Grade I proficiency test in Sinhala within one year, Grade II proficiency test within two years and Grade III proficiency test (where applicable, within three years from the date of appointment)

Failure to pass a test within the prescribed period for it, will result in the suspension of increments. Suspension will be converted to stoppage if the test is not passed within a further period of six months beyond the prescribed period, such stoppage operating until the test is passed or until such time as the provisions of section 4:1:5 below apply.

- 4:1:5 The provisions of Section 12:13 of Chapter II of the Establishments Code will apply if the prescribed standard of proficiency in Sinhala is not reached by the end of the period of probation.
- 4:1:6 Sections 4:1:3, 4:1:4 and 4:1:5 will not apply to those recruited through the Sinhala medium.
- 4:1:7 A State Officer already confirmed in a permanent post in the State Service will not normally be required to serve the period of probation on being appointed to another permanent post in the State Serv.ce. Such officer may in the first instance be appointed to act in the new post for a specified period with a view to testing him in his new post.
- 4:1:8 Selected candidates (other than those aiready holding permanent/temporary appointments in the State Service who have already been medically examined) will be required to undergo a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer to test their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

5. Terms of Engagement

5:1 All State Officers appointed to the State Service after 1.1.72 either to posts in the permanent establishment or to posts in the monthly paid temporary cadre (excluding those on daily rates of pay) will be required to contribute 6% of their consolidated salary to the Public Service Provident Fund. The State will contribute 9% of the consolidated salary paid in at the close of each financial year. The holder of such an appointment may also, if he so desires make

6. War Service Concession

6:1 If they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of United Kingdom's Fighting Forces and full-time members of Auxillary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services will, provided they had not left these Services of their own accord, be allowed to deduct periods of such service from September 3, 1939 to December 31, 1949, from their age for purposes of obtaining eligibility on grounds of age provided that they had joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

7. Serving Officers in the State Service

- 7:1 Applications from officers of the State Service who possess all the necessary qualifications must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from State Officers holding posts in the permanent establishment in the State Service, the Heads of Departments, in forwarding such applications, should state whether the applicants could be released or not to take up the new appointment, if selected.

Japanese Government Scholarships—1974

APPLICATIONS are invited for the award of post-graduate scholarships, offered by the Government of Japan, for study or research in the following fields:—

Engineering, Agriculture, Fisheries, Domestic Science.

The scholarships are meant or persons of good intellectual promise who may be expected to make a significant contribution to the life of the country on their return after completion of the scholarship.

Note 1.—No application from a Government Servant will be entertained unless the Head of his/her Department certifies in terms of Treasury Circular No. 514 of 16.05.60 that the training provided by the scholarship is essential in connection with a project and the particulars of such project are indicated in that circular.

Note 2.—Applications from employees of Boards, Corporations, Universities and similar Government-aided or sponsored Institutions should be sent through the Heads of respective institutions, who should be requested to complete the certificate in cage 27 of the application appropriately, when forwarding the application

Note 3.—Each applicant should send only one application and should apply only for one course of study.

2. Tenure.—The duration of the scholarships will normally be two years from April, 1974, or one and a half years from October, 1974.

Scholarships are, however, liable to be terminated at any time during the currency of the course at the discretion of the Japanese authorities for misconduct, irregularity in attendance absence without permission of the authorities concerned from College or Hostel or unsatisfactory progress in studies or failure to pass examinations. In such an eventuality, the scholar might be required to return to Sri Lanka at his/her own expense.

- 3. Eligibility.—Candidates should—
- (i) be citizens of Sri Lanka;
- (ii) be less than 35 years of age on 01.04.1974 (i.e. who were born on or after 02.04.1939);

- (iii) possess at least a degree of a recognised university, appropriate for post-graduate studies in the desired field of study. (No applications will be accepted pending results);
- (iv) be willing to study the Japanese Language (as the medium of instruction is Japanese)

Note 1.—A candidate who has entered into a Bond or Agreement to serve the Republic of Sri Lanka or in a Board, Corporation, University or other State-aided or sponsored institution for a specific period shall not be eligible to apply unless by 01.04.1974, he/she has served the period specifies in the Bond or Agreement and discharged fully the obligations entered into the Bond or Agreement.

 - (d) not to apply for any other post outside the department or for a further period of study leave until the completion of the stipulated period of service and the full discharge of the obligations of the bond.
- (iii) Those teachers who have received appointments under the District Service Scheme and enter Training Colleges for training are bound to serve in the same districts after the completion of training.
- 3. Salary.—Trainees who satisfactorily complete the course and receive appointments as teachers will be placed on the salary scale applicable to them on the date of new appointment.
- No candidate will be eligible for admission to a course given in Sinhala/Tamil unless he/she has the S.S.C or G.C.E. (O.L.) with Sinhala/Tamil.
 - 5. The training will be available in the following special subject areas:-
 - (1) English
 - (2) Mathematics
 - (3) Science

A-GENERAL

- A Candidate should be :---
 - (i) of good character; (ii) a citizen of Ceylon;
 - (iii) should be under 45 years on 1.1.74;
 - (iv) should have received an appointment as a teacher before 31.12.72;
 - (v) should satisfy the Sinhala/Tamil Language requirement given in regulation 4;
 - (vi) should have passed the G.C.E. (O.L.) /S.S.C in 6 subjects on not more than 2 occasions including Sinhala/Tamil Language and Arithmetic/Commercial Arithmetic/Mathematics.  - (1) A Pass in Wood-work;
 - (2) A Pass in Metal work;
 - (3) A Pass in Geometrical Drawing;
 - (4) A Pass in Physics.
 - (ii) For Women. At the S.S.C. or G.C.E. (O/L) two of the following subjects:-
 - (1) A Pass in Weaving;
 - (2) A Pass in Pottery;
 - (3) A Pass in Art or Pass in Geometrical Drawing;
 - (4) A Pass in Chemistry.

Note I.—The Ceylon Technical College Industrial Teachers' Certificate or the Certificate awarded by the Government College of Fine Arts on successful completion of a 3 year course in one of the required crafts or the Final Certificate in Weaving of the Department of Cottage Industries, will be accepted in lieu of a pass in the crafts at the G.C.E. (O/L) /S.S.C. These Certificates will however not be accepted for purposes of completing the six subjects or the S.S.C. indicated in para 6 (vi) above giving the general requirements.

 - (x) The Sinhala Teachers' Certificate with Accountancy and one other subject out of the following:—Commerce, Commercial Arithmetic, Economics, Shorthand and Typewriting.
 - (xi) At the S.S.C. or G.C.E. (O/L) Passes in Accountancy and any two of Commercial Arithmetic, Mathematics, Elements of Commerce, Economics, Shorthand and Typewriting;
 - Shorthand and Typewriting wil lbe counted as one subject except for those who have passed in 1962 or earleir.
- (f) For the Home Science Course, one of the following:-
 - (i) At the G.C.E. (O/L)/S.S.C.
 - (a) Passes in two of the following subjects with one at Credit Level—Home Science, Home Craft, Needlework,
 - (b) A Pass in one of the following subjects:

- (ii) Certificate in Agriculture of the Kundasale Girls' Farm School (including Home Science and Needle work) obtained after a 2 year course.
