Hours of Inspection

The office shall be open to the public for inspection of the register on every working day from nine a.m. to three p.m. and on every half day from nine a.m. to eleven a.m. Applications for inspection of the register will, however, be accepted up to 2 p.m. on working days and 11 a.m. on half days.

Trade Marks limited to Colours

Where it is stated in the advertisement of an application that the mark upon its registration is to be limited to

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated under Section 23 of the Prade Marks Ordinanes (Cap. 131) with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

Application in Part A or Part B

Application for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number

OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has ground of objection to the registration of the following Trade Mark may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge Notice of Opposition on form T.M. No. 7 bearing an uncancelled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expenses of preparing the Notice of Opposition are incured. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.


