2. Specification of Silk Worm Rearing Tray.—The tray should be 3 feet by 4 feet with the plank on the four sides $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches high and half inch thick. The bottom of the tray should have strips of wood one inch broad and half inch thick spaced half inch apart from the edge of one strip to the next. These strips should be fixed parallel to the 3 feet side of the tray. The bottom of the tray should have fitted below the strips mentioned above four trips of wood half inch by half inch with the lower edges rounded and running parallel to the four foot side of the tray and placed such that two strips run under the side plank on the four foot side of the tray but below the strips running parallel to the 3 feet side. The other two strips should be so fixed such that they divide the balance space left into three equal spaces. Each corner should be strengthened by fixing triangular pieces of plank 3 inch long on the 3 and 4 feet sides.

All wood used should be of well matured sapu and smoothly planned. All joints should be closely and firmly fitted and all nails driven well in.

In general the completed tray should be as in marked sealed specimen at the office of the Project manager, Sericulture Project, Pallekelle, Kengalla with the exception that the strips of wood at the bottom should be as in this specification.

3.
