I do also hereby order that, subject to the Rules of Discipline issued by the Cabinet of Ministers or any further or other Orders issued by the Cabinet of Ministers or by me, powers of dismissal and disciplinary control not delegated by the fromer Public Service Commission as aforesaid, but exercised by itself, other than the power to order compulsory retirement for inefficiency as an alternative to dismissal, shall now be exercised in respect of State Officers the initial of whose consolidated salary is less than Rs. 6,720 per annum by the Heads of the Departments specified in the Schedule hereto.

Regulation

The Apart Ownership Regulations, 1973, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 63/6 of June 12, 1973, are hereby amended as follows:-

- (1) by the insertion, immediately after regulation 10, of the following new regulations:-
 - "11. Where an application is made under section 3 of the Apartment Ownership Law to register a Condominium Plan of a Condominium property subject to a mortgage registered under the Registration of Documents Ordinance not earlier than 30 years from the date of such application, the Registrar shall not register such Condominium Plan unless-
 - (a) the mortgage has consented in writing to the registration of the Condominium plan; or
 - (b) the Registrar is satisfied that the mortgagor has given a valid undertaking to the mortgagee, to create, immediately upon registration of the Condominium Plan, a fresh mortgage charging such number of units of the registered Condominium Property as in the opinion of the Registrar may be necessary to secure the outstanding liabilities on the former mortgage.

- 12. Every mortgager who has given an undertaking referred to in paragraph (b) of regulation 11 shall carry out such undertaking immediately upon registration of the Condominium Plan.
- 13. The provisions of regulations 11 and 12 shall apply mutatis mutandis to an application made under Section 12 of the Apartment Ownership Law for the registration of a Plan of redivision or amalgamation.
- 14. Every Notary Public, attesting a declaration made under Section 5 or Section 12 of the Apartment Ownership Law, shall also certify that, to the best of his knowledge, the applicant or applicants, is or are the owner or owners, and the only owner or owners, of the Condominium Property or the units, as the case may be.
- 15. Every person applying for the registration of a Condominium Plan shall attach to the copy of the Plan marked 'Duplicate' a certificate obtained from the local authority under section 5 (2) of the Apartment Ownership Law."; and
- (2) in the Schedule thereto-
 - (a) by the substitution for item 15 of Form B, of the following new item-
 - (15). ATTESTATION AND CERTIFICATE OF NOTARY. The Notary's attestation should conform to sub-section (20) and (2) of section 31 of the Notaries Ordinance (Chapter 107) and the certificate should be in terms of regulation 14"; and
 - (b) by the substitution for item 11 of Form C, of the following new item:-
 - "(11) ATTESTATION AND CERTIFICATE OF NOTARY. The Notary's attestation conform to subsection (20) and (21) of section 31 of the Notaries Ordinance (Chapter 107) and the certificate should be in terms of regulation 14".

THE Weekly issue of the Gazette of the Republic of Sri Lanka (Ceylon) is normally published on Fridays: If a Friday happens to be a Public Holiday the Gazette is published on the working day immediately preceding the Friday. Thus the last date specified for the receipt of notices for publication in the Gazette also varies depending on the incidence of public holidays in the week concerned.

The Schedule below shows the dates of publication and the latest time by which notices should be received for publication in the respective weekly Gazette. All notices received out of times specified below will not be published. Such notices will be returned to the sender by post for necessary amendment and return if publication is desired in a subsequent issue of the Gazette. It will be in the interest of all concerned if those desirous of ensuring the timely publication of notices in the Gazette make it a point to see that sufficient time is allowed for postal transmission of notices to the Government Press.

The Government Printer does not accept payments of subscriptions for the Government Gazette. Payments should be made direct to the Superintendent, Government Publications Bureau, P. O. Box 500, Secretariat, Colombo 1.

Note.—Payments for inserting Notices in the Gazette of the Republic of Sri Lanka (Ceylon) will be received by the Government Printer and not by the Superintendent, Government Publications Bureau.
