2. Allowances

- 4:1:2 All State Officers who are "New Entrants" to the State Service, for purposes of the official language policy of the State are required to conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any aws and rules that now exist or may be introluced in the future to give effect to the language policy of the State.
- 4:1:3 All State Officers are required to acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language during their period of probation.
