Hearings in respect of this dispute were held on 16.7.73, 11.8.73, 22.8.73, 27.8.73, 11.9.73 and 29.10.73, the Union being represented by Mr. N. Sanmugathasan, General Secretary of the Union, and the Employer by Mr. R. L. Jayasuriya, instructed by Messrs. Julius & Creasy.

“ As agreed on the last date it has not been possible to re-examine the books of the Company because the strike is still continuing. But nevertheless, and independently of that, the Union wishes to make the following statement:—

In the course of the present inquiry certain evidence has been led and elicited which makes the Union believe that the statement of the dispute in question does not correctly reflect the actual dispute that exists between the Management and the Union. Therefore, the Union, while reserving to itself the right to re-agitate with the Management the dispute in a form which it thinks suitable, does not wish to proceed with the present inquiry and does not seek any relief from the arbitrator. Under the circumstances, there being no dispute between the Management and the Union, it would request that the Arbitrator makes no award or grant any relief.”

Mr. R. L. Jayasuriya, Counsel for the Employer, stated that “ in view of the submission made by the Union he would like to place on record that the Union is not entitled to re-agitate this dispute by seeking a re-reference by the Honourable the Minister under the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act.”
