# GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS IN THE STATE SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA (CEYLON)"

1. General Qualifications required

- 1:1 Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration as defined in the Ceylon Citizenship Act.
- 1:2 A Candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination should have a pass in the Sinhala Language obtained at the Senior School Certificate Examination or its equivalent if he is a Sinhalese, educated in the Sinhala medium. (This requirement will not apply to those who are in the State Service from a date prior to January 1, 1961, and who seek appointments to other posts in the State Service).
- 1:3 Applications from the 'New Entrant' public officers whose probationary/trial appointments have been terminated for failure to pass the prescribed Proficiency Test in Sinhala will not be entertained unless they have obtained the qualifications which would entitle them to seek exemptions from the highest Proficiency Test in Sinhala prescribed for the post or service in terms of Treasury Circular No. 640.

2:1 In addition to the monthly consolidated salary applicable to the post, all monthly paid married officers in the State Service will be paid a Married Allowance on the basis set out in Section 1 of Chapter VIII of the Establishments Code.

- 2:2 Monthly paid State Officers in the salary/ wage group ranging from Rs. 180 to Rs. 250 per month (inclusive of all allowances), will be paid a Special Allowance of Rs. 7.50 per mensem subject to any adjustments where necessary.
- 3. Conditions of Service: General
- 3:1 All officers in the State Service will be subject to the Financial Regulations, the Establishments Code, Departmental Orders or Regulations and any other Orders or Regulations that may be issued by Government from time to
- 3:2 A State Officer may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officer's (Security) Ordinance, in such sum and in such manner as the Secretary to the Ministry concerned may determine.
- 3:3 A State officer may be called upon to serve in any part of the Island.
- 4. Conditions of Service applicable to State Officers holding permanent appointments
- 4:1 In addition to the conditions referred to in Section 3 above, State Officers holding permanent appointments will be subject to the following further conditions:
- 4:1:1 All appointments will be on probation for a period of 3 years unless a longer period is considered necessary in respect of any post. An appointment may be terminated at any time during the period of probation without a reason being assigned.

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- 4:1:2 All State Officers who are "New Entrants" to the State Service, for purposes of the official language policy of the State are required to conform to the provisions of the Official Lanuage Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any laws and rules that now exist or may be introduced in the future to give effect to the language policy of the State.
- 4:1:3 All State Officers are required to acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language during their period of probation.
- 4:1:4 Confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation will depend, *inter alia*, on the passing of the Grade I, proficiency test in Sinhala within one year, Grade II proficiency test within two years and Grade III proficiency test in (where applicable, within three years from the date of appointment).

Failure to pass a test within the prescribed period for it, will result in the suspension of increments. Suspension will be converted to stoppage if the test is not passed within a further period of six months beyond the prescribed period, such stoppage operating until the test is passed or until such time as the provisions of section 4:1:5 below apply.

- 4:1:5 The provisions of Section 12:13 of Chapter II of the Establishments Code will apply if the prescribed standard of proficiency in Sinhala is not reached by the end of the period of probation.
- 4:1:6 Sections 4:1:3, 4:1:4 and 4:1:5 will not apply to those recruited through the Sinhala medium.
- 4:1:7 A State Officer already confirmed in a permanent post in the State Service will not normally be required to serve the period of probation on being appointed to another permanent post in the State Service. Such officer may in the first instance be appointed to act in the new post for a specified period with a view to testing him in his new post.
- 4:1:8 Selected candidates (other than those already holding permanent/temporary appointments in the State Service who have already been medically examined) will be required to undergo a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer to test their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

## 5. Terms of Engagement

5:1 All State Officers appointed to the State Service after 1.1.72 either to posts in the permanent establishment or to posts in the monthly paid temporary cadre (excluding those on daily rates of pay) will be required to contribute 6% of their consolidated salary to the Public Service Provident Fund. The State will contribute 9% of the consolidated salary paid in at the close of each financial year. The holder of such an appointment may also, if he so desires make a further voluntary contribution at his option up

- to 6% of his monthly consolidated salary to the Public Service Provident Fund but no contribution will be made by the State on such contribution.
- 5: 2 Those State Officers who held permanent and pensionable posts in the State Service prior to 31.12.1971, if appointed to a post in the permanent establishment of the State Service after 1.1.1972, will be allowed to retain the pensionability as personal to the holder. Such State Officer will be required to contribute to the Widows' & Orphans' Pension Scheme as before.

# 6. War Service Concession

6:1 If they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of United Kingdom's Fighting Forces and full-time members of Auxillary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services will, provided they had not left these Services of their own accord, be allowed to deduct periods of such service from September 3, 1939 to December 31, 1949, from their age for purposes of obtaining eligibility on grounds of age provided that they had joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

# 7. Serving Officers in the State Service

- 7:1 Applications from officers of the State Service who possess all the necessary qualifications must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from State Officers holding posts in the permanent establishment in the State Service, the Heads of Departments, in forwarding such applications, should state whether the applicants could be released or not to take up the new appointment, if selected.
- 7:2 Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.
- 7:3 Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or any attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.
- 7:4 Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification, if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal, if discovered after the selection.
- 7:5 Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of the advertisement will be rejected.

- 2. Applications are invited from candidates who possess the qualifications and satisfy the conditions given below:—
  - 3. (a) General Conditions .- A candidate must-
  - (i) be a citizen of Ceylon;

- (iii) be of good character;

Note.—Where a candidate possesses the technical or special knowledge required for a particular appointment, the age limit may be raised to 45, and/or the educational requirements waived. This will especially apply in the case of applicants to the Stoker Mechanic/Electrician, Steward, Cook and Driver branches.

- 4. Mode of Recruitment.—Successful candidates will be appointed to branches upon enlistment. Their confirmation in branch will depend upon their performance at the Recruit Training Course. At the completion of such course, selectees are liable to transfer of branch or discharge at the discretion of the Captain of the Navy.
- 5. Conditions of Service.—Conditions of service will be governed by the Seamen's Enlistment and Service Regulations, 1950, (published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 10,187 of December 9, 1950) which are in force on the date of enlistment and the aforesaid regulations as amended from time to time thereafter.
- 6. Period of Engagement.—(a) A successful candidate will be engaged, in the first instance for a period of 5 years. If his service during the period is satisfactory, his servce can be extended by 7 years and 10 years respectively. Generally, he will serve for a period of 22 years only, when he will become entitled to provident fund benefits.
- (b) Notwithstanding to the contrary every engagement or re-engagement will be terminated upon the sailor reaching 55 years of age.

- (b) Seamen trained as specialists by the Service will be entitled to a slightly higher scale of pay.
- (c) A married seams shall be paid a Married Allowance as such rate as in applicable to him on the same terms and conditions obtaining in Government Service. Other Allowances will be paid in accordance with the Navy Pay Code, 1972.
  - 8. The following rules govern applications for enlistment:—
  - (a) Applications must be made as per specimen application form appearing at the end of this notice.
  - (b) Applications are to be addressed to the Captain of the Navy, Navy Headquarters, P. O. Pox 593. Colombo 1. Envelopes should be marked "RECRUITMENT—SAILORS" on the top left-hand corner, and should reach Naval Headquarters before 12 noon on January 22, 1974.
  - (c) Applications from Government employees should be forwarded through the Head of the Department concerned, together with a letter from the Head of the Department stating that the applicant will be released if selected.

- 9. Official Language.—Successful candidates enlisted in the Regular Naval Force should subscribe in writing to the condition that they will conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any regulations, orders or instructions pertaining to same that may exist at the time of enlistment or which may be issued from time to time thereafter for giving effect to the language policy of the Government.
- 10. An ex-Serviceman seeking preference for these vacancies must, in addition to the General Conditions mentioned above, furnish proof—
  - (a) that he has not less than one year's service in the Armed Forces of Sri Lanka, the British Commenwealth or the Ceylon Defence Forces;

A two years institutional course of training Arabic teachers in the Tamil Medium will be conducted at Addalaichenai Teachers' College

This course is intended to prepare teachers for the purpose of teaching Arabic and allied subjects in Primary and Secondary schools.

- (ii) A trainee who fails to satisfy the Principal of the Teachers' College in regard to general conduct and diligence in studies discontinued from the course. The decision of the Director General of Education in this matter will be final. will be discontinued from the course.
- (iii) A trainee is ordinarily not permitted during the course of training to follow any other external course or take any other external examination.
- 2. Admission.—(i) The course is not meant for the following categories of candidates. If such a candidate gains admission his/her admission will be declared null and void at any stage during the training course or thereafter.
  - (a) Teachers who have already received a course of training at a Guru Vidyalaya or are at present receiving a course of training.
  - (b) Teachers who hold a degree
  - (c) Teachers who on or before the day of closing of applications do not satisfy all conditions of elibibility to apply as given in para. 4.
- (ii) Every candidate should furnish to the Principal within two weeks of admission all documents necessary for entering into a bond of value equivalent to his/her salary inclusive of all allowances and cost of training for the period of training, where the candidate
  - (a) not to participate in political activity during the period of trainig;
  - (b) not to abandon the course of training for any reason whatsoever;
  - (c) on completion of the course of training to serve as a teacher for a continuous period of eight years in schools to which he/she will be appointed by the D.G.E.;
  - (d) not to apply for any other post outside the Department or for a further period of study leave until the completion of the stipulated period of service and the full discharge of the obligations of the bond.
- (iii) Salary.—Trainees who satisfactorily complete the course and receive appointment as teachers will be placed on the appropriate salary scale applicable to them on the date of new appointment.
  - 4. Eligibility.—I. A candidate should--
    - (i) be of good character;
    - (ii) be a citizen of Ceylon;
    - (iii) have received an appointment as a teacher before the closing date of applications but selections will be made strictly according to seniority;
    - (iv) be below 45 years of age on 01.01.74.
  - II. No candidate will be eligible for admission to a course given in the Tamil Medium unless he/she has the following:
    - (a) Parts I and II of the Al-Alim preliminary examination conducted by the Department of Examinations;

- 5. Application for selection.—(1) Application must be made by completing an entry form prepared by the candidate according to the specimen form as appearing in this Gazette notification. Application must be made in the Tamil Medium. No printed form will be issued by the Ministry of Education. In the preparation of the entry form the following requirements must be strictly adhered to. Disregarding any one of them will result in the rejection of the application.
  - (a) the form must be prepared on a sheet of foolscap paper measuring approximately  $16'' \times 13''$  and not on any other paper;
  - (b) the form may be prepared on a typewriter. If perpared by hand, it should be drawn up in red ink. The filling in of the cages must be done in blue or black ink.
  - (c) the cages should be ruled and should be in the correct order and on the correct face of the paper. No cage should be altered or omitted. The cages should be intelligently spaced on the paper and any cramping or overcrowding avoided.
- (2) The entry form should be fully and accurately filled in by the candidate. An entry form which is not complete will be judged on its own merits and may be rejected. The attention of the candidates is drawn to the following:—
  - (a) a teacher should give his name as it has been registered in the department;
  - (b) every teacher should indicate wheter he/she is a teacher or pupil teacher and give the date of first appointment and Registered Number;
  - (c) the application must be forwarded through the head of the school where the applicant is a teacher;
  - (d) the completed application must be enclosed in an envelope on the left side of which the following words be clearly written:—
