Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number.

OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has ground of objection to the registration of the following Trade Mark may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge Notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expenses of preparing the Notice of Opposition are incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken in to account in considering any application by an opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.
