It is ordered that the petitioner as the widow of the said deceased is hereby entitled to have lotters of administration to the intestate estate of the said deceased and that letters be issued to her, unless the above named respondents or any persons interested shall, on or before January 30, 1945, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
