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DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

L. D.—O. 35/44.

An Ordinance to amend the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1943.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1945.
- 2. The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 24 of the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), and shall have effect as section 24A thereof:—
 - 24A. (1) The Board may, pending any issue of debentures, raise from any person, for the purpose of carrying on the business of the corporation, a loan, repayable within a period not exceeding twelve months, of such sum or sums of money and on such terms and conditions relating to the rate and payment of interest, as the Board of Ministers may approve.

(2) The principal of, and interest due upon, every loan raised under sub-section (1) shall, as they fall due, be paid out of the funds of the corporation, and the payment thereof shall be guaranteed by the Government of Ceylon in writing under the signature of the Deputy Financial Secretary.

3. Section 37 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution, for "24, 25", of "24, 24A, 25".

Objects and Reasons.

Under the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1943, the Board of Directors of the Agricultural and Industrial Credit Corporation of Ceylon can, for the purposes of the Ordinance, borrow only from the Ceylon Government or, by means of the issue of debentures, from the general public. That Ordinance does not give the Board power, pending any issue of debentures, to borrow, on behalf of the corporation, from the public. As the inclusion in the Ordinance of a provision giving the Board such a power would be useful, it is proposed by this Bill to amend that Ordinance, so as to enable the Board, pending any issue of debentures, to raise a loan from any person on the guarantee of the Ceylon Government. According to the proposed amendment, the amount of the loan and the terms and conditions as to the rate and payment of interest should be approved by the Board of Ministers, while the loan should be repaid within a period not exceeding twelve months.
