REGULATION made by the Minister of Plantation Industry under section 10 of the Tea Subsidy Act, No. 12 of 1958, as amended by Act No. 66 of 1961, Act No. 33 of 1966 and Act No. 4 of 1970.

Regulation

The Tea Subsidy (Diversification to-Approved Crops) Regulations, 1970, published in *Gazette* No. 14,932 of November 12, 1970, as amended by regulations published in *Gazette* No. 40 of December 29, 1972, are hereby further amended by the substitution for regulation 15 thereof the following regulation:—

“ 15 (1) The amount of subsidy payable for replanting the whole or any specified part of a tea estate or tea small holding with rubber, on tea diversification permits issued prior to September 1, 1974, shall be Rs. 1,400 in respect of each acre of the area to be replanted, and shall be paid in five instalments in the following manner:—

- (a) the first instalment of Rs. 200 for each acre shall be paid after the eradication of the existing tea plants and other vegetation in the area to be replanted;
- (b) the second instalment of Rs. 300 for each acre shall be paid after the adoption of soil conservation measures and the completion of replanting with rubber budded stumps or clonal seedlings;
- (c) the third instalment of Rs. 300 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than one year after the completion of the replanting;
- (d) the fourth instalment of Rs. 300 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than two years after the completion of the replanting; and

(e) the fifth instalment of Rs. 300 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than three years after the completion of the replanting.

(2) The amount of subsidy payable for replanting the whole or any specified part of a tea estate or tea small holding with rubber on tea diversification permits issued on or after September 1, 1974, shall be paid Rs. 2,000 in respect of each acre of the area to be replanted, and shall be paid in six instalments as follows in the following manner:

- (a) the first instalment of Rs. 200 for each acre shall be paid after the eradication of the existing tea plants and other vegetation in the area to be replanted;
- (b) the second instalment of Rs. 350 for each acre shall be paid after the adoption of soil conservation measures and the completion of replanting with rubber budded stumps or clonal seedlings;
- (c) the third instalment of Rs. 350 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than one year after the completion of the replanting;
- (d) the fourth instalment of Rs. 350 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than two years after the completion of the replanting;
- (e) the fifth instalment of Rs. 350 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than three years after the completion of the replanting; and
- (f) the sixth instalment of Rs. 400 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than four years after the completion of the replanting.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of this regulation, the instalments or subsidy falling due for payment on or after September 1, 1974, in respect of replanting permits issued prior to September 1, 1974, may be paid at the rates specified in paragraph (2) of this regulation.

The powers specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto are hereby delegated to the State officers specified in the corresponding entry in Column II of that Schedule, subject to the following conditions:—

- (a) These powers shall be exercised subject to the Rules of discipline and such other instructions as may be issued from time to time by the Cabinet of Ministers or the Minister of Health.
- (b) Any person dissatisfied with the decision made by a State officer under any power delegated to such officer under this delegation may—
 - (i) appeal to State Services Disciplinary Board, if that decision is made by the Commissioner of Ayurveda, the Director of Ayurvedic Research Institute, the Principal of the College of Ayurveda, the Medical Superintendents of Ayurvedic Hospitals, the Assistant Commissioner of Ayurveda, the Accountant of the Department of Ayurveda, the Office Assistant, the Medical Officers-in-Charge of Ayurvedic Hospitals or the Hospital Secretary.
 - (ii) Nothing contained herein shall be deemed or construed to derogate from or to affect in any other way the right of appeal to the Minister, conferred by Section 119 of the Constitution of Sri Lanka.

I consider the above settlement just and equitable and make my award accordingly.
