THE NAVY ACT

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Defence and Foreign Affairs under section 161 of the Navy Act (Chapter 358) as amended by Act No. 11 of 1962.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Navy (Board of Inquiry) Regulations, 1975.

2. A Board of Inquiry may be assembled by an order in writing by the Captain of the Navy:

3. A Board of Inquiry shall be composed of one to three officers who may be from any branch or department of the Navy, depending on the nature of the investigation.

4. The Captain of the Navy shall appoint a member of the board to act as President:

Provided that no such appointment shall be necessary where the board consists of only one officer, and in every such case such officer shall be the President of the Board.

5. The proceedings of a Board of Inquiry may be used by the Captain of the Navy to enable him to arrive at a conclusion on any matter which he requires to be informed on, or upon which there may be a question whether it should form the subject of a Court Martial.

6. Where in the opinion of the Captain of the Navy any of the matters to be referred to the Board of Inquiry also relate to the Sri Lanka Army or the Sri Lanka Air Force, or where it appears to the Captain of the Navy that it is desirable to have an officer of the Sri Lanka Army or Sri Lanka Air Force on the Board of Inquiry, the Captain of the Navy may, with the consent of the Commander of the Army or the Commander of the Air Force, appoint one or more Army or Air Force Officers, as the case may be, to be members of the board of inquiry. Provided however, that in every such case, the President of the board shall be the officer appointed President by the Captain of the Navy.

7. The Captain of the Navy shall furnish the Board with terms of reference, stating in detail the character of the investigation required and prescribing the nature of any report or declaration to be made in the findings.

8. Adequate notice shall be given by the President of the date, time and place the Board of Inquiry, shall assemble and of all further sittings of the board to all persons concerned in the inquiry.

9. A Board of Inquiry shall not be vested with power to award any punishment. It may, however, be vested with power not exceeding that of the assembling authority, which may be necessary for the proper conducting of the inquiry such as calling before it Navy, Army or Air Force personnel as the case may be, as witnesses and requiring the production of all evidence. It may be re-assembled as often, and with such alternations in its composition as may be directed.

10. A Board of Inquiry is not a judicial body; it shall not have power to examine witnesses on oath.

11. A Board of Inquiry, unless otherwise ordered, shall sit with closed doors.

12. No person shall be present at a Board of Inquiry in the capacity of a prosecutor, nor is any friend or professional adviser to be allowed to assist any person concerned in the inquiry.

13. Whenever any inquiry affects the character or professional reputation of a person subject to Naval law, full opportunity shall be afforded to that person of being present throughout the inquiry, and of making any statement and of giving any evidence he may wish to make or give, and of cross-examining any witnesses whose evidence in his opinion affects his character or professional reputation and of producing any witnesses in defence of his character or professional reputation.

14. It shall be the duty of a Board of Inquiry to put such questions to a witness as it may think desirable for the purpose of testing the truth or accuracy of any evidence he has given, and for eliciting the truth. In order to ensure that a witness may not be compelled to answer a question which may tend to directly or indirectly incriminate him, he shall be cautioned, before being examined, in the following terms and the fact that he has been so cautioned shall be recorded in the minutes:—

(a) *For witnesses subject to Naval Law*

"You are privileged to refuse to answer any question, the answer to which may tend to expose you to any penalty or forfeiture; it is for you to raise the objection and for the board to decide whether you must answer the question or not".

(b) *For witnesses not subject to Naval Law*

"This Board is inquiring into a matter affecting the Naval service and is confident that you will give it all assistance in your power. You are not, however, legally obliged to answer any question the answer to which may tend to expose you to any penalty".

15. If the inquiry should have reference to the loss or hazarding of a ship or vessel, the Commanding Officer of the ship or vessel shall make available to the board such of the following documents as exists and relevant to the inquiry:—

(a) The ship's log book,

(b) The rough and fair engine room registers,

(c) The chart or charts and sailing directions by which the ship was navigated,

(d) The last table of compass deviations.

(e) The navigational data book and the gyro compass, log,

(f) The Commanding Officer's night order book,

(g) The Navigating Officer's note book and work book.

16. The minutes of the proceedings of the Board shall be signed by all members of the Board and forwarded by the President to the Captain of the Navy. The written instructions issued to the Board by the Captain of the Navy shall be included with the minutes. In the event of a difference of opinion among the members of a Board of Inquiry on a material point, the grounds of difference shall be stated in detail.

17. Any sketches or diagrams which may be produced during the proceedings in order to illustrate the evidence of a witness shall be attached to the minutes.

18. The record of the proceedings of a Board of Inquiry shall be treated as a strictly service document and copies shall not be sent or shown to any person except on the authority of the Captain of the Navy.

19. To prevent any unauthorised publication of the proceedings, the President shall decide how many copies of the minutes are to be made and all such copies shall be forwarded to the Captain of the Navy. Where a stenographer has been employed, the shorthand notes shall be attached to the copy or copies of the transcript tendered to the Captain of the Navy.

20. The evidence recorded of each witness is to be read over to him at the conclusion of his evidence and signed by him and counter signed by the President of the Board.

21. The proceedings of a Board of Inquiry, or any confession, statement or answer to a question made or given at a Board of Inquiry shall, subject to any other law, not be admissible or given in evidence against any person at any other inquiry or trial except at the trial of such person for wilfully giving false evidence before the Board.

22. At the discretion of the convening authority before a court-martial and of the judge advocate during trial, the minutes of evidence taken at a Board of Inquiry (but not other portions of the record of proceedings such as findings and recommendations) may be supplied to the accused or his friend upon request. Such request may normally be granted unless the convening authority or judge advocate considers that the interests of the service or the attainment of justice would be damaged by such disclosure; and the appropriate authority may impose such conditions (e.g., disclosure of portions of the minutes of evidence only; restrictions upon the persons to whom access is allowed) as he may deem to be required by the above mentioned considerations. Where the charge is one arising out of the giving of evidence before a Board of Inquiry, the accused must always be provided with at least the relevant portions of the minutes of evidence.

Award

The Hon. the Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, (Chapter 131), as subsequently amended, has referred the abovementioned industrial dispute to me for settlement by arbitration by his Order dated 27th May, 1974.

The matter in dispute between the above-mentioned parties, according to the Statement accompanying the Order, is whether the termination of the services of the workers whose names are set out above, commencing with 1. Mr. Dharmadasa Jayalath and ending with 10. Mr. R. A. M. Perera, by the management of Lanka Press, 91, Kotte Road, Colombo 8, is justified and to what relief each of them is entitled.

In his pleadings, as well as in evidence Mr. Kumarasamy has stated that he is a member of the Ceylon Communist Party,

and that in 1946 he was appointed General Treasurer of the Party. As there is no provision in law to register a press in the name of a political party, he states, his name was registered as the proprietor of the Lanka Press. He further states that he has in no way directly or indirectly been responsible for the termination of the services of the workers referred to above. Consequently, he wished to be discharged from the proceedings.

It is not disputed that, at the time of the discontinuance of those workers from service, Mr. Kumarasamy's name appeared as the registered owner of the Lanka Press. In the circumstances, I am of the view that he must take responsibility for what was done by or on behalf of that Press.

However, the workers designated 1 to 9 above have arrived at a settlement. Mr. H. G. S. Ratnawera, Assistant Secretary of the Communist Party, has on behalf of Mr. Chellappa Kumarasamy, produced an affidavit signed by Mr. Dharmadasa Jayalath, who appeared on behalf of all the workers, stating that all the workers have arrived at a settlement. There is one exception, Mr. R. A. M. Perera (No. 10 in the list) who was present and said he did not wish to be included in the settlement. The terms of the settlement are not mentioned, but workers 1 to 9 wish to withdraw the demands they have made in this case. As a satisfactory settlement has been made, I accede to the withdrawal of the complaint against the respondent by workers 1 to 9. This seems to me just and equitable and I make award accordingly.

The industrial dispute between Mr. R. A. M. Perera and Mr. Chellappa Kumarasamy, however, remains.

The evidence of Mr. Perera is that he has been employed at the Lanka Press from November 1st, 1967, till February 2nd 1973. After work on February 2nd, 1973, he went to sign off, when he was asked by the manager to work overtime. Mr. Perera excused himself on the ground that he was unwell and had to go for treatment. The next day he was not given work, and on the 5th February he was handed a letter stating that as he had refused to work overtime on the 2nd and had been warned for late attendance on several occasions, he should give written explanation why disciplinary action should not be taken against him. This explanation he gave by registered letter on 6th February. In that letter he repeated the reason already given for not working overtime, and he denied that he had ever been warned for late attendance. No inquiry was held. This evidence is uncontradicted.

It may well be that there are reasons for discontinuing Mr. Perera from employment. But he was certainly entitled to an inquiry. I hold that he was wrongfully dismissed. I think it would be just and equitable if he is given as compensation a month's wages, that is to say, Rs. 833 for each of the five full years in which he was employed. I make award accordingly.

I also order that the respondent shall deposit this total sum of Rs. 1,665 with the Assistant Commissioner of Labour, (Colombo Central) within one month of the publication of this award in the *Gazette of the Republic of Sri Lanka*.
