IT is hereby notified that the Special Commissioner, Dharga Town has under section 129 (b) of the Town Councils Ordinance (Chapter 256), and with the sanction of the Commissioner of Local Government, given by virtue of the powers delegated to him, imposed for the year 1975, subject to such limits and exemptions as may be prescribed by by-laws a Special Conservancy rate of two per centum of the annual value of all immovable property situated within the Town of Dharga Town, payable in four equal instalments on March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31, respectively.

GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE ADVERTISED IN PART IV OF THE "GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA (CEYLON)"

- 2. Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Local Government Service Act, No. 18 of 1969, and Local Government Service Regulations and any other conditions of service as laid down by the Commission from time to time.
- 3. Terms of Engagement.—(a) All those who are appointed to monthly paid posts in the Local Government Service will contribute to the Local Government Service Provident Fund. The employee will be required to contribute 6% of his consolidated salary. The Local Authority to which he is appointed will contribute 9% of his consolidated salary to the Fund on his
- (b) The pension rights of officers serving under Government (d) The Widows' and Orphans' Pension Scheme will not apply will be conserved if released under Section 21 of the Government to persons appointed to monthly-paid Posts in the Local
- 1. Allowance.—Married allowance is payable at rates and on conditions applicable to Government Officers.

  Minutes on Pensions and transferred to pensionable posts in the Local Government Service. Any person who holds a pensionable Local Government Service. Any person who holds a pensionable post in the Local Government Service, if he is promoted or appointed to any other pensionable post in the Service will continue to enjoy pension rights in the new post to which he is appointed or promoted.

However, all those who hold pensionable posts in Local Government Service and are appointed or promoted to any other pensionable post in the Service, other than females, those above the age of 55 and those who are holding pensionable posts in the Government Service on the date immediately prior to their appointment to the Local Government Service, are required to contribute 4% of their hypothetical basic salary to the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund established under the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Regulation, 1952, published in the Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 10,329 of July 30, 1952. The Local Authority will contribute 3% of the hypothetical basic salary of the officer concerned.

- (e) Appointees may be required to furnish security either in cash or by Fidelity Guarantee Bond through a Guarantee Association approved by the Local Government Service Commission in a sum which may be decided upon by the Local Authority.
- (f) Appointees not holding scheduled posts in the Local Government Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a duly qualified medical practitioner as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.
- (g) The appointment will generally be on probation or subject to confirmation after a period of 3 years unless otherwise specified.
- (h) Applicants should be prepared to produce their Birth Certificate or certificates of probable age in lieu thereof when called upon to do so.
  - (i) Appointees should serve in any part of the Island.
- 4. New-Entrants to the Local Government Service.—(i) The period of probation/trial of "New-Entrant Officers" appointed to pensionable posts/non-pensionable posts, as the case may be, shall be 3 years unless a longer period is prescribed in respect of any posts.
- (ii) All New-Entrant Officers must subscribe to the conditions that they will conform to the provisions of the Official Language Act, No. 33 of 1956, and any laws and rules that now exist or may be introduced in future for giving effect to the language policy of the Government.
- (iii) They should acquire a working knowledge of the Official Language—Sinhala—during their period of probation/trial except on exceptional cases where it is not essential for the efficient discharge of their duties.
- (v) Their confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation trial will depend, inter alia, on their passing within the prescribed period of time prescribed Proficiency Tests in Sinhala leading up to a level not higher than the J.S.C. Standard. Failure to pass these tests within the prescribed period will result in the non-payment of increments falling due until the tests are passed. The service of those officers who do not reach the required standard of Proficiency in Sinhala by the end of their period of probation/trial will be liable to be terminated.
- (v) Educational and other Qualifications.—In all schemes of recruitment where the minimum qualification prescribed is a pass in the S.S.C. examination or equivalent or higher examination a candidate who is a Sinhalese educated in the Sinhala medium should have a pass in the Sinhala Language or its equivalent obtained at the Senior School Certificate or equivalent examination.

This requirement will not apply to those officers who have been in the Local Government Service from a date prior to February 8, 1963, and who seek appointments to other posts in the Local Government Service.

Note.—(i) Those who qualify for entry into the Local Government Service through the Sinhala medium will be exempted from passing these proficiency tests in Sinhala as a pre-requisite for confirmation.

Note.—(ii) The term "New Entrants" shall for the purpose of the Official Language policy, apply to an officer who was first appointed to a post in the Local Government Service in response to a Gazette Notification published on or after 29.01.60.

Note.—(iii) The provisions of paragraph 4 (iii) and (iv) will not apply to old entrant officers serving in Government Departments and who have been released from their posts to accept appointments in the Local Government Service.

- 5. Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A Ceylonese is a citizen of Sri Lanka by descent or by registration.
- 6. Concessions to ex-servicemen.—(a) Ex-servicemen will be allowed to deduct their period of service in the Regular Force from their ages, where such deduction will enable them to be brought within the maximum age prescribed in the posts applied for.

- (b) Ex-servicemen will be allowed to reduce the minimum educational standards laid down in the scheme of recruitment to any post in the Service to the next lowest examination.
- 7. Age Concession.—Employees of Local Authorities holding permanent posts with two years' continuous service are eligible to apply irrespective of age for posts advertised in the Local Government Service.
- 8. Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from those in Local Body should be forwarded through the Municipal Commissioner or Chairman of the Local Authority in which they are serving.
- (ii) Applications from officers in the Government Service should be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Government Service, the Head of the Department concerned should when forwarding the aplication, state whether or not he is prepared to release the applicant, if selected.

2. Salary.—The salary scale attached to the post is Rs. 4,152— $144 \times 17$  and  $8 \times 180$ —Rs. 8,040 per annum with an Efficiency Bar before Rs. 6,024 and an Efficiency Bar before Rs. 7,500 per annum. A married allowance too will be paid to married officers.

The selected candidates will be required to pass the First Professional Examination of the Diploma Course in Valuation of the Ceylon Technical College before they could proceed beyond the Efficiency Bar before Rs. 6,024 per annum.

- 8. Qualifications required:
- (a) Not less than 18 years nor more than 30 years of age on 15.4.1975;
- (b) (i) Applicants should have successfuly completed the Second Year Academical Examination of the Diploma Course in Valuation of the Ceylon Technical College; or
  - (ii) They should have successfully completed the Third Year Evening Course in Building Construction of the Ceylon Technical College together with the Two Years' Evening Course in Builders Quantities and Surveying and Levelling and have had two years practical experience in rating subsequent to obtaining the above qualifications.

Preference will be given to those with the qualifications referred to at (b) (i).

4. In the absence of candidates with the necessary practical experience in rating, applications will also be considered from those who have completed the technical qualifications referred to in Para. 3 (b) (ii) above, but have no practical experience.

Such a candidate, is appointed, will be placed on the following salary steps :-

Those possessing one year's practical experience 1st year—Rs. 4,008 per annum; 2nd year—Rs. 4,152 per annum.

Those without practical experience-1st year—Rs. 3,864 per annum; 2nd year—Rs. 3,008 per annum; 3rd year—Rs. 4,152 per annum.

# THE MUNICIPAL COUNCILS ORDINANCE

BY-LAWS made by the Municipal Council of Kurunegala under sections 267 and 272 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252) and approved by the Minister of Local Government by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 268 of that Ordinance, and confirmed by the National State Assembly.

#### By-laws

- 1. In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires—
  "Commissioner" means the Municipal Commissioner appointed under the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252), and "Licensed Premises" means the premises in which the holder of a licence under these by-laws is authorized to keep or rear swine.
- 2. No person shall keep or rear swine within the limits of the Municipality of Kurunegala, unless he is the holder of an annual licence issued in that behalf by the Commissioner.
- 3. Every licence under these by-laws shall, unless earlier cancelled as hereinafter provided, remain in force, until the thirty first day of December of the year in respect of which it is issued.
- 4. For each licence issued under these by-laws, a fee shall be payable as laid down by the Council.
- 5. No licence issued under these by-laws shall be transferable.
- 6. No licence shall be issued in respect of any premises unless such premises and the sty to be used therein are in conformity with the following conditions:—
- (a) the site must be approved by the Commissioner;
- (b) a proper and adequate water supply to the premises must be provided;
- (c) adequate provision must be made for draining the premises;
- (d) the sty must have a floor made of cement or other impervious material and must be surrounded by a wall at least three feet in height and cement plastered;
- (e) the sty must be situated at least fifty feet away from any dweling house or street;
- a ffy-proof bin must be provided for the deposit of dung, filth or other offensive or noxious matter resulting from the keeping of swine in the premises;

- (g) adjoining the sty there must be a compound enclosed in a manner capable of preventing swine straying from such compound.
- 7. It shall be lawful for the Commissioner, or for any officer of the Council generally or specially authorised in writing thereto by the Commissioner, at all reasonable times between surrise and sunset to enter upon and inspect any licensed premises.
- 8. In the event of the licensed premises ceasing to be in conformity with the conditions laid down for the issue of the licence; the Commissioner may, by written notice served on the licensee, require him to take such measures as may be specified in the notice in order to bring the premises in conformity with those conditions.
- 9. Where, for any reason, personal service of any notice under by-law 8 cannot be effected upon a licensee, the notice shall be deemed to be duly served on him if it is left at his last known place of residence or is affixed to some conspicuous object or in a conspicuous position upon the licensed premises.
- 10. The licensee shall comply with the requirements of any notice served on him, within such time as may be stated in the notice, and if no period is specified, within seven days from the date of service of the notice.
- 11. Every licensee shall keep the licensed premises in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 12. Every licensee shall report forthwith to the Medical Officer of Health any disease or death among the swine kept in the licensed premises.
- 13. In the event of any swine dying of disease in the licensed premises, the licensee shall not bury or otherwise, dispose of the carcase of such swine without the prior sanction of the Medical Officer of Health.
- 14. It shall be lawful for any person, authorised by the Commissioner in writing, to seize or cause to be seized any swine found straying outside the licensed premises of the owner of such swine.
- 15. Every contravention of any of these by-laws shall be punishable with a fine not exceeding Rs. 50, and in the case of a cotinuing offence, with an additional fine not exceeding Rs. 15, for every day during which the offence is continued after conviction, or after written notice of such contravention.
- 16. On a second or subsequent conviction of a licensee by court for any contravention of any of these by-laws, the licensee held by him shall be liable to cancellation by such court without prejudice to any other punishment that may lawfully be imposed in respect of such contravention.
