- (2) In respect of each such day of work in any month as is in excess of the minimum number of working days specified in respect of that month in paragraph 3 (1) the minimum rate of wages payable shall be an amount equal to one and a half-times the minimum daily rate ascretained by dividing the minimum monthly rate by 25.

Where a worker of any class specified in this Part has commenced employment in the course of any month, he shall be paid as wages for that month an amount which bears to the minimum monthly rate specified in respect of that class in this Part the proportion which the period of his employment bears to the minimum number of working days specified in repect of that month in paragraph 3 (1).

Where by resaon of any unauthorised absence a worker of any class specified in this part has not worked in any month during the minumum number of working days specified in repsect of that month in paragraph 3 (1), he shall be paid as wages for that month an amount which bears to the minimum monthly rate specified in respect of that class in this Part the proportion which the difference between such minimum number of working days and the number of days of unauthorised absence bears to such minimum
- 6. Absence from work on holidays, on days on which the employer fails to provide work, and on days for which leave with full pay is allowed to a worker, shall not be deemed to be unauthorised absence.
- For the purposes of computing the wages of a worker, a holiday referred to in Part III shall be deemed to be a day on which the worker has worked.

BY virtue of the powers delegated to me by Excise Notification No. 509 published in *Gazette* No. 13,529 of February 22, 1963, I, Herath Banda Wijekoon, Excise Commissioner, do hereby direct under section 25 of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 52), that on and after April 01, 1975—

- (1) the rates prescribed in the Schedule herete, shall be the rates at which arrack shall be sold in any premises licensed for the sale of foreign liquor, in lieu of any rates prescribed heretofore in that behalf in any Excise Notification whatsoever, relating to the sale of foreign liquor; and
- (2) that Excise Notification No. 613 published in Gazette No. 140 of November 28, 1974, be reseinded.
