ACOUSED PERSONS WANTED.

HAPUTANTRIGE PUN SINGHO alias PODY SINNO (habitual criminal No. 1,016) ; charged with failing to report himself to the Superintendent of Police, Colombo, on October 29, 1899 ; is a Sinhalese of the Goigama caste; religion Buddhist; occupation, carter; age, about 27 years; height, 5 ft. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.; make, well built; complexion, brown; mouth, small; teeth, fairly regular; eyes, brown and oval; hair, black and cut long; moustaches and beard, scraggy; has a mole on right side of forehead, a mole on right ear, three scars on right forearm, a scar on right side of back, a scar on right knee, and a scar on right shin; birthplace and general residence, Kelaniya, Colombo; haunts Pettah and Maradana; mistress, Kuihamy of Kelaniya; brother, Marthelis of Kelaniya; sister, Alice Nona of Temple road, Colombo; uncle, Juan of Kelaniya; is well known to Elaris, Police Vidane of Kelaniya, Police Constables 228 Zain Drahim and 1,113 Adam, both of Pettah, and Inspectors Pietersz and Ludovic. The Police Magistrate of Colombo has issued warrant No. 62,777 for his arrest. A reward of Rs. 25 is offered for his apprehension. This notice amends the notice regarding this accused published in "Hue and Cry" No. 1,729 of March 23, 1900.

CROOS ; charged with house-breaking and theft at Kirimetiya estate, Batapola, on April 11, 1900; is a Tamil of the Wellala caste; occupation, cooly; age, about 50 years; height, 5 ft. 2 in.; complexion, fair; teeth, well set; eyes, brown and round; hair, tied in a kudumbi; beard, shaved; ears, bored; birthplace, India; general residence, Kirimetiya estate, Batapola; haunts Maradana, Colombo; single; is well known to Messrs. Emaliya Mendis, Proctor, John Mendis, and Lewis Mendis, the proprietors of Kirimetiya estate, and to the Police Officer of Batapola. The Police Magistrate of Balapitiya has issued warrant No. 20,176 for his arrest.

KODIKARAGEDERA PUNCHIRALA alias WATTULIADDE GODAGEDERA PUNCHIRALA ; charged with escape from lawful custody at Seeremalawatta on April 13, 1900, whilst being escorted to Kandy Police Court on a charge of criminal breach of trust; is a Sinhalese; religion, Buddhist; occupation, carter; age, 36 years; height, about 5 ft. 6 in.; make, spare; complexion, dark brown; two front teeth broken half; eyes, somewhat reddish and round; hair, long, and tied in a knot; whiskers, cut round; has a scar on right side of forehead; birthplace, Bombra; general residence, Doraliadde; haunts Teldeniya, Matale, and Kandy; kept a mistress named Wallagedera Punchi Menika at Doraliadde; brother, Herangedara Keerala Appuhamy, said to be at Anuradhapura; is well known to the Police Constables 812 N. A. Sader and 1,088 S. M. Joseph and E. Ebramsha. The Police Magistrate of Urugala has issued warrant No. 10,773 for his arrest.

CORNELIS ; charged with theft at St. Sebastian on May 7, 1900; is a Sinhalese of the Wellala caste; religion, Buddhist; occupation, servant; age, 18 years; height, 5 ft. 6 in.; make, thin; complexion, fair; teeth, regular; hair, black and cut short; moustaches, just growing; birthplace Kalutara; general residences, Kalutara and Colombo; haunts Kalutara and Colombo; single; is well known to E. F. Jayasuriya of St. Sebastian street. The Police Magistrate of Colombo has issued warrant No. 64,510 for his arrest.
