No 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expenses of preparing the notice of Opposition are incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

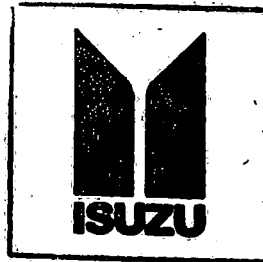
