STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 3: The legal effect of the new section 63 inserted in the Coconut Development Act will be to extend the provisions of that Act to the palmyrah and other palms to be specified by the Minister.

A LAW TO AMEND THE COCONUT DEVELOPMENT ACT,
No. 46 OF 1971.

BE it enacted by the National State Assembly of the Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited the Coconut Development (Amendment) Law, No. of 1975. Short title.

5 2. The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 62, and shall have effect as section 63 of the Coconut Development Act:— Insertion of new section 63 in the Coconut Development Act, No. 46 of 1971.

10 “ Reference to coconut to be construed as including reference to palmyrah, and certain other palms.

63. Any reference in sections 20, 22, 23, 30, 44, 45, 46, 48, 49, 50, 51 and 62 to coconut, shall unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as including a reference to palmyrah and to such other palms as may be specified by the Minister by Order published in the *Gazette*, and the expressions ‘ coconut product ’, ‘ coconut plantation ’, ‘ coconut palm ’, and ‘ coconut industry ’, occurring in these sections shall be construed accordingly.”
