THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATION made by the President under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulation

1. (1) The Board of Directors of a Public Corporation or the person entrusted with the management of such Corporation may, in its or his absolute discretion, suspend the services of any employee of such Corporation if such employee is suspected of—

- (a) having engaged in any activity which is prejudicial to the interests of, or dangerous to the security of, the lawfully established Government of Sri Lanka ; or
- (b) complicity with, or being privy to, the activities of any organization which has been proscribed by any emergency regulation ; or
- (c) having contravened or failed to comply with any emergency regulation or any order or rule made thereunder.

(2) Where the services of an employee of a Public Corporation are suspended under paragraph (1), he shall not be entitled to be paid any salary or allowance during the period of the suspension of his services :

Provided, however, that the Board of Directors of such Corporation or the person entrusted with the management of such Corporation may in its or his absolute discretion pay such employee one-half of the salary to which he is ordinarily entitled, together with or without any allowances.

(3) The suspension of the services of an employee of a Public Corporation or the non-payment of the salary or allowances of such employee under this regulation shall not be challenged before any court or tribunal.

(4) The provisions of this regulation shall have effect notwithstanding anything in any other law or the terms and conditions of any contract of service between employees of a Public Corporation and the Public Corporation.

(5) In this regulation, " Public Corporation " means a Corporation the capital of which is partly or wholly subscribed by the Government.
