Food Price Order No. T/PC/12

WHEAT FLOUR

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 read with Section 3(2) of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Sinnapodiyan Patkunam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Administrative District of Trincomalee, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke the Food Price Order No. T/PC/10 of 20th August, 1974, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary of the Republic of Sri Lanka (Ceylon)* No. 126/3 of 26.08.1974;
- (ii) fix the prices specified in Column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the Maximum Wholesale Price per one hundred weight above which Wheat Flour shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the First Schedule;
- (iii) fix the prices specified in Column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the Maximum Retail Prices per pound above which Wheat Flour shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of the Second Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of Wheat Flour in a quantity of 112 lbs. or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour less than 112 lbs. for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "Wheat Flour" shall be deemed to include any mixture of Wheat Flour with maize flour;
- (v) direct that no person shall sell Wheat Flour mixed with any other article except maize flour;
- (vi) direct that no person shall sell any mixture of Wheat Flour and maize flour which contain more than 10 per cent. by weight of maize flour;
- (vii) direct that every area where Maximum Prices are fixed by this Order every trader who has any Wheat Flour in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of Wheat Flour in a suitable container with the Maximum Prices for Wheat Flour fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the Maximum Prices could be clearly seen by any customer;
- (viii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "Pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (ix) direct that when any Wheat Flour is sold, the Maximum Prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such Wheat Flour is sold;
- (x) direct that in every area where Maximum Prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells Wheat Flour by whole sale shall and every person who sells Wheat Flour by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the quantity of Wheat Flour sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold, and
 - (d) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by Wholesale or by Retail.

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THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 of the Control of Prices Act (Chapter 173), I, Wilfrid Jayasuriya, Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do hereby revoke with immediate effect the Control of Prices (Shirts) Order No. 1 of 1975 published in the *Gazette Extraordinary of the Republic of Sri Lanka (Ceylon)* No. 147/62 of 21.01.1975 and Order as follows:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Shirts) Order No. 2 of 1975.
- (2) This Order shall apply to the whole of Sri Lanka,
- (3) The prices specified in each entry in Column II of the Schedule hereto shall with immediate effect, be the retail dealer's maximum retail price per shirt above which any shirts of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Column I of that Schedule shall not be sold to any person.
- (4) Every trader or dealer who has for purposes of sale, any quantity of shirts of the description set out in Column I of the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the brand names of the shirts and in figures not less than one inch in height, the maximum price of such shirts fixed by this Order so as to be clearly seen by any customer.
- (5) Every person who sells any shirts of the description set out in Column I of the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of shirts sold; and
 - (c) the price charged for the number of shirts sold.
- (6) Every person carrying on business as a trader or dealer in any shirts of the description set out in Column I of the Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th May, 1975, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stocks of such shirts in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept.
- (7) This Order shall not apply to shirts subjected to or manufactured from material subjected to any or all of the following processes if the coloured, printed or printed area of the shirt as a result of such proceeding is not less than 50 per centum of the total surface area of the shirt—
 - (a) Batik,
 - (b) Tie and Dye,
 - (c) Screen Printing.
- (8) The maximum price specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container if any, in which such shirt is sold.
