"GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA (CEYLON)" EFFECTIVE
AS FROM 1st MARCH, 1976**

(Issued every Friday)

1. All Notices and Advertisements are published at the risk of the Advertisers.
2. All Notices and Advertisements by Private Advertisers may be handed in or send direct by post together with full payment to the Government Printer, Government Press, Colombo.
3. The office hours are from 8 a.m. to 4.15 pm.
4. Cash transactions will be from 8.30 a.m. to 2.45 p.m.
5. All Notices and Advertisements must be pre-paid. Notices and Advertisements sent direct by post should be accompanied by Money Order, Postal Order or Cheque, made payable to the Government Printer. Postage stamps will not be accepted in payment of Advertisements.
6. To avoid errors and delay "copy" should be on one side of the paper only and preferably typewritten
7. All signatures should be repeated in block letters below the written signature.
8. Notices re change of name from Non-Government Servants and Trade Advertisements are not accepted for publication.
9. Advertisements purporting to be issued under Orders of Courts will not be inserted unless signed or attested by a Proctor of the Supreme Court.

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PUBLICATION OF A GAZETTE

Such notices will be returned to the sender by post for necessary amendment and return if publication is desired in a subsequent issue of the *Gazette*.
