This Assembly resolves, under the provisions of section 3(b) of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 268), that with effect from 1.3,76 the aforesaid Ordinance shall be in force within the area defined in the Schedule hereto.

# Rules

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Avissawella Resthouse Rules, 1976
- 2. Fees at the rates set out in the Schedule hereto, shall be paid by every person using or occupying any part of the rest-bouse. A service charge of ten per centum on the total value of every bill shall be recovered by the resthouse keeper.
- 3. (1) Every visitor shall, on his admission to the resthouse write legibly in the register maintained for the purpose at the resthouse, his name and address and the date and time of arrival at that resthouse.
- (2) No visitor shall occupy any part of the resthouse or be served, until he has complied with the requirements of the preceding paragraph.
- (3) On leaving the resthouse, every visitor shall write the date and the time of departure in the register maintained for the purpose at the resthouse.
- 4. (1) Resthouse fees shall be paid in cash on demand.
- (2) A receipt giving details of services rendered and charges made therefore, shall be issued by the resthouse keeper to every visitor.
- 5. The value or repair costs of all articles damaged or broken by any visitor or his servants. shall be paid by that visitor. The resthouse keeper shall include this charge in receipt issued to the visitor.
- 6. (1) The resthouse keeper shall keep a complaint book in which the visitors shall enter any complaint or remarks about the resthouse or its management.
- (2) It shall be the duty of the resthouse keeper to produce the complaint book when called upon to do so.
- 7. No vehicle shall be kept in the premises of the resthouse, without the permission of the resthouse keeper, unless such vehicle is owned by a visitor to the resthouse.
- 8. (1) Any visitor who desires to book accommodation at the resthouse in advance may do so by giving to the resthouse keeper at least three clear days' notice.
- (2) The notice referred to in paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by a remittance of Rs. 5 per person.
- (8) A telegraphic request for reservation of accommodation and supply of meals must state the name and address of the search, and shall be accompanied by the prescribed fees.

- (4) The remittance shall be forefeited if the accommodation booked is not taken as arranged. Provided that 24 hours notice of the cancellation of such booking is received by the resthouse keeper, the remittance may be refunded.
- 9. A breach of any of these rules shall be punishable with a fine not exceeding fifty rupees.
- 10. The following fees collected by the resthouse keeper shall be paid promptly to the credit of the general fund of the Council:

(a) Occupation charges

... full amount

(b) Service charges

... 50%

(c) Disturvance fees(d) Garage fees

... 50%

11. All Resthouse rules heretofore made are brescinded.

BY-LAWS made by the Ratnapura Municipal Council under sections 267 and 272 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance (Chapter 252), and approved by the Minister of Local Government under section 268 of that Ordinance.

By-laws relating to the Ratnapura Public Library

- 1. In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "librarian" means the person appointed by the Local Government Service Department to be in charge of the Library. The term "library assistant" means an assistant to the librarian.
- 2. The Patnapura Public Library established and maintained by the Ranapura Municipal Council shall consist of—
  - (a) a lending library;
  - (b) a reference library;

  - (c) a reading room;
    (d) a children's library, and
    (e) a branch library.
- 3. (1) The general administration of the Public Library shall be vested in a library standing committee (hereinafter referred to as the "standing committee") composed of members of the Council not exceeding four as may be elected or nominated by the Council.
- (2) The librarian in charge of the Public Library shall be responsible for the maintenance of order in the Library, and he shall also function as ex-office Secretary of the library standing committee. Members elected or nominated under paragraph (1) shall hold office for one year from the date of election or nomination and shall be eligible for re-election.
- 4. The standing committee shall have the power to allow any person to use any part of the premises of the Public Library, subject to such conditions as it may deem necessary, or to refuse such person the use of any part of those premises, if such person has contravered any of these by-laws.

# Lending Library

- (1) No person shall be admitted as a member of the lending library unless he-
  - (a) is not less than 14 years of age,
  - (b) is literate: and
  - (c) is guaranteed by an occupier or owner of a house within the Municipal Limits fetching a monthly rental of not less than rupees fifty (Rs. 50).
- (2) A person who is a resident or having an office or a place of business within the administrative limits of the Council may be admitted as a member of the lending library on the payment of a sum of rupees five (Rs. 5) to the library. A person resident outside the administrative limits of the Municipal Council may be enrolled as a member—
  - (a) on the payment of a sum of rupees five to the librarian: and
- of a monthly subscription of one rupee.
- (3) Every person desirous of being admitted as a member of the lending library shall make application in that behalf on a form obtainable from the librarian on payment of a sum of cents fifty (.50 cts.).
- (4) The guarantor shall be liable for all fines, books and reading materials incurred by the member.
- 6. The librarian shall issue two tickets to every person who is admitted as a member of the lending library and they shall be left at the library whenever books are borrowed. A member shall be entitled to borrow one book at a time on each such ticket
- 7. A member of the lending library shall be responsible for any book removed from such library on a ticket issued to him.
- 8. Where a member of the lending library loses a ticket issued to him under by-law 6, he shall immediately give notice to the librarian of such loss. If the librarian is sutisnotice to the librarian of such loss. If the librarian is satisfield that no book has been borrowed from the lending library on tuch ticket he may issue a duplicate ticket on the payment of a sum of cents fifty on each such ticket. No duplicate ticket shall be issued by the librarian unless there has elansed at least a period of thirty days from the date on which the loss was brought to his notice. The issue of a duplicate ticket shall not release a borrow from his responsibility for books which may at any time be taken out with his original ticket.
- 9. Any change of residence or place of work on the part of the borrower must be intimated in writing to the librarian within one week of such change under penalty of the forfeiture of the deposit and tickets. The re-issue of the tickets shall be at the discretion of the librarian.

- 10. Any member ceasing to reside within the Municipal area or ceasing to use the library shall return his tickets to the library, in order to have them cancelled. Such member shall otherwise be held responsible for any books taken out
- 11. Membership shall be renewed every year by making an application in that behalf accompanied by a guarantee in terms of by-law 5(1)(c). No fee is payable for such renewal.
- 12. (1) Any book borrowed by a member from the lending library shall be returned to the librarian within a period of 14 days from the date of issue.
- (2) Any book that is not called for by any other borrower, may be renewed for a further period of 14 days. Books may be so renewed by producing them personally at the inbrary or by a letter, addressed to the librarian.
- 13. Where a member fails to return any book he has borrowed from the lending library with the period of fourteen days referred to in by-law 12, a fine of ten cents per day on each book shall be levied for every day such book is overdue after the due date. Sundays and public holidays shall not be counted for this purpose.
- 14. Where a member fails to return any book he has borrowed from the lending library within thirty days from the date on which it was borrowed the Council shall be entitled to take legal action to recover either from the borrower or the guarantor, with costs, the value of such book or at the option of the Council, double the value thereof, together with binding charges and detention fee due on such overdue book, in terms of bylay 13 of by law 13.
- 15. No member shall cause damage to or injure any book he has borrowed from the lending library. Members shall keep the books clean and shall not turn down the leaves or make pencil or other marks upon them.
- 16. It shall be the duty of every member to bring to the notice of the librarian any damage or injury to any book he intends to borrow from the lending library. Where he fails to bring any such damage or injury to the notice of the librarian such book shall be presumed to have been issued to him without such injury or damage.
- 17. Where the Librarian is satisfied that any book returned by a member has been soiled (except by fair wear and tear), written in, marked or otherwise injured, he may charge the members the value of the book. Where the member fails to make such payment the council may institute legal action to recover such amount together with costs. Where a member replaces a book with a new copy or pays its value he shall be entitled to the damaged copy, after it has been stamped "Ratnapura Public Library sold as damaged".
- 18. (a) No member shall lend to any person any book borrowed by him from the lending library.
- (a) of this by-law shall cease to be a member of the lending library.
- 19. (a) No member shall return to the lending library any book which to him knowledge has been used by any person suffering from an infectious, contagious or cutaneous disease.
- (b) Where a book borrrowed from the Lending Library by a member has been used by any person suffering from any infactious, contagious or cutaneous disease, such book shall be destroyed and that member shall pay to the librarian the cost of its replacement.
- 20. Where any dispute arises between two or more members of the lending library as to which member should borrow a particular book the decision of the librarian shall prevail.
- 21. Any member who desires to borrow any book which has already been borrowed by another member, shall enter his name and the title of the book in a register kept for that purpose and the librarian shall, on such book being returned by the member who borrowed it issue it to the member who has entered his name in the register. Where two or more members have entered their names in the register for any particular book, then such book shall be issued to them in order in which the book had been reserved. in which the book had been reserved.
- 22. The opening time and the closing time of every branch of the Library shall be altered as proposed from time to time by the Standing Committee.

# Reference Library

- 23. (1) No person shall make use of the reference library unless he has-
  - (a) obtained permission from the librarian for the purpose;
  - (b) has signed the register kept in the referrence library.

  - (2) The librarian may permit any person who-
  - (a) is literate.
  - (b) is resident within the municipal area; and
  - (c) is not less than 14 years of age,
  - To make use of the reference library.

24. No person shall take out of the reference library any book given to him for the purpose of reference, or any other book or part thereof any pamphlet, periodical, picture, painting, engraving, map, chart, plan, manuscript, document, print or newspaper forming part of the collection of the library, except with the prior approval of the Mayor or the Municipal Commissions. missioner.

#### Children's Library

- 25. No person shall make use of the reading room unless he-
- (a) has obtained permission from the librarian for the purpose, and
- (b) has signed the register kept in the reading room.
- 26. No person shall remove from the Reading Room any newspaper periodical, magazine, map, document, manuscript, newspaper periodical, magazine, map, document, manuscript, print, chart painting, picture, engraving, pamphlet or any other article placed in or belonging to the reading room or the library.

# Children's Library

- 27. Children who either reside or attend a school within the administrative limits of the Municipal Council are eligible to be admitted as members of the children's library.
- 28. No child shall be admitted as a member of the Children's library unless he-
  - (a) is not less than 6 years of age and not more than 14 years of age,
  - (b) is literate.
- 29. Every child desirous of being admitted as a member of the nildren's library shall comply with the following rechildren's quirements:-
  - (a) A sum of Rupees two and cents fifty shall be deposited with the Librarian.
  - (b) Children attending school shall get their applications endorsed by the Principal of the school.
- 30 Two tickets shall be issued to a person admitted as a member for the children's library and such tickets will entitle him to borrow two books at a time. The tickets shall be left at the library whenever books are borrowed.
- 31. Members are cautioned against losing their tickets as they will be responsible for all books taken out with such tickets
- 32. The guarantor shall be liable for all fines, losses and damage to books, reading materials and other articles, incurred by the members.
- 33. Where a member of the children's library losses a tickets issued to him under by law 30, he shall immediately give notice to the librarian of such loss. If the librarian is satisfied that no book has been borrowed from the children's library on such ticket the Librarian may issue to such member a duplicate ticket on the payment of a sum of twenty-five cents. No duplicate ticket shall be issued by the Librarian unless there has elapsed at least a period of thirty days from the date on which such loss was brought to his notice. The issue of a duplicate ticket shall not release a borrower from his responsibility for books which may at any time be taken out with his original ticket.
- 34. Where a member fails to return any book he has borrowed from the Children's library within the period of fourteen days referred to in by-law 12 a fine of five cents per day per book shall be levied for each day's detention after the due date. Sundays and public holidays shall not be counted for this purpose.
- 25. Where a member fails to return any book he has borrowed from the Children's library within thirty days from the date on which it was borrowed the Council shall be entitled to take steps to recover either from the borrower, parent or the guarantor

by action at law with costs, the value of such book or at the option of the Council, double the value thereof plus binding charges and detention fees due on such overdue book, in terms of by-law 34.

36. By laws 11, 15, 16, 18, 19, 21 and 22 shall apply to the children's library.

#### General

- 37. No person who is suffering or has recently suffered from and contagious, infectious or cutaneous disease or has recently been in attendance on any person suffering from such disease shall enter the premises of the Library until the period of infection and incubation has elapsed.
  - 38. No person shall-
    - (i) behave in a disorderly manner or commit any nuisance in or about the premises of the public library;
    - (ii) damage or in any way deface any portion of the building or any property of the Council in or about the public library;
    - (iii) enter, remain or loiter about the premises of the public library, after such library is closed, without being able to give a satisfactory account of himself;
    - (iv) smoke or spit within the premises of the public library;
    - (v) gamble with dice or cards or play any games within the premises of the public library;
    - (vi) disturb the users of the public library by shouting, singing songs or making any other noise in such library;
    - (vii) enter the premises of the public library improperly clad:
  - (viii) bring any dog or other animal into the premises of the public library;
  - (ix) sleep or eat any food in any part of the premises of the public library;
  - (x) enter or remain in any part of the Library not set apart for the purpose;
  - (xi) assign any responsibility for the safe keeping or any article such as hats, umbrellas, sticks, bags, parcels or any other articles. Such articles shall be kept at the borrower's or reader's own risk.
  - (xii) wilfully, carelessly or negligently spail, tear, cut, deface, write upon, damage, injure or destroy any book or document forming part of the contents of the library or any property, furniture or fittings therein.
  - (xiii) obstruct the librarian or any person acting under the orders of the librarian in the lawful exercise of his powers under these by-laws.
  - 39. Any person who, in the premises of the Library -
  - (a) behaves in a disorderly manner;
  - (b) uses violent, abusive or obscense language;
  - (c) bets or gamble or who after being warned persists in remaining in the library beyond the hours fixed for the closing thereof, or who is not entitled to the use of the library, or who is suffering from an infectious or contagious disease may be excluded or removed from the library by an officer or servant of the library or of the
- 40. Every contravention of by-laws 26, by-law 37, paragra h i, ii, iii, iv, v, vi, vii, viii, ix, x, xi, xii, or xiii of by-law 38 at by-law 39 of there by-laws shall be punishable with a fine not exceeding fifty rupees.
- 41. The membership of any person who contravenes by-law 14. 15, 17, 18, 24, 26, 37, 38 and 39 shall be cancelled by the Mayor and such member shall not be entitled, under any circumstances to enrol as a new member.
