THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE

REGULATIONS made by the President under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance, upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulations

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency (Coconut Products) Regulations.
- 2. No person shall during the continuance in force of these regulations export copra or coconut oil from Sri Lanka notwithstanding any export licence issued to him permitting any such export:

Provided, however, that the preceding provisions shall not apply in relation to—

- (a) the export, commencing on and after December 1, 1973, of a total quantity of coconut oil not exceeding 150,000 metric tons on one or more valid export licences issued by the Coconut Marketing Board established under the Coconut Development Act, No. 46 of 1971; and
- (b) the export, commencing on and after July 10, 1974, of a total quantity of Estate No. 1 grade of copra not exceeding 3,048 metric tons on one or more valid export licences issued by the Coconut Marketing Board established under the Coconut Development Act, No. 46 of 1971.
- 3. Every person who carries on business as a miller of coconut oil and who is required to be registered as such under regulation 2 of the Coconut Development Regulations, No. 1 of 1972, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 15,009/1 of May 5, 1972, is hereby required to deliver all coconut oil manufactured by him or in his possession to the Coconut Marketing Board established under the Coconut Development Act, No. 46 of 1971, or to any person, authorised by the said Coconut Marketing Board to take delivery of such oil. The price to be paid for coconut oil delivered to or to the order of the Coconut Marketing Board, shall be as determined by the Coconut Marketing Board.
