THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATIONS made by the President under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance, upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulations

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency (Protection of Public Property) Regulations.
- 2. (1) Any person who, without lawful authority or reasonable excuse, the proof whereof shall lie on such person, has in his possession, custody or control any property belonging to the Railway Department, the Telecommunications Department, the Ceylon Transport Board or the Ceylon Electricity Board or who commits theft or mischief in respect of such property shall be guilty of an offence.

In this paragraph "theft" and "mischief" have the same meanings respectively as in the Penal Code.

- (2) A certificate purporting to be under the hand of an officer specified in column I of the Schedule hereto in the case of the Department or Board specified in the corresponding entry of column II of that Schedule certifying that the property in question belongs to the Railway Department, the Telecommunications Department, the Ceylon Transport Board or the Ceylon Electricity Board, as the case be, shall be admissible in a court of law and shall be prima facie proof of the truth of the statements made therein.
- (3) Any person guilty of an offence under this regulation shall on conviction before a Magistrate be liable to a term of imprisonment not less than 5 years and not exceeding 7 years.
