THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 40)

REGULATIONS made by the President under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance, upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency (Suspension of Local Authorities) Regulations.

2. Notwithstanding anything in any other written law, the administration of any local authority duly constituted under any written law shall on an order made by the Competent Authority appointed under these regulations be vested in the Assistant Commissioner of Local Government of the administrative region within which that local authority is situated for so long and for so long only as these regulations remain in force, and accordingly, such Assistant Commissioner shall during the aforesaid period exercise all the powers and perform all the duties of that local authority and of the Chairman or Mayor thereof under the provisions of any written law.

3. In regulation 2, "local authority" means any Municipal Council, Urban Council, Town Council or Village Council.
