### **By-Laws**

#### VILLAGE COUNCILS ORDINANCE

#### By-law relating to Public Markets

For the purpose of By-law I of Part XXVII of the Standard by-laws relating to Public Markets adopted by the Village Council of the Biyagama village area in the Colombo District, the area within the following limits is hereby declared as the Market area for the Kadawata Public Market:—

- North: By a line drawn from a point on the northern boundary of the Biyagama-Mahara V.C. area projecting to the  $9\frac{1}{2}$  mile post on Colombo-Kandy Road, northeastwards along the said boundary to a point in line with the centre point of the culvert No. 11/1, on Colombo-Kandy road ;
- East: By a line drawn from the last mentioned point southwards to the centre point of the culvert No. 11/1 on Colombo-Kandy Road, thence to an imaginary point 300 feet south of the centre line of the said Colombo-Kandy road;
- South: By a line drawn from the last mentioned point southwestwards parallel to and at a distance of 300 feet from the centre line of Colombo-Kandy road to a point in line with the  $9\frac{1}{2}$  mile post on the said road;
- West: By a line drawn from the last mentioned point northwards across the  $9\frac{1}{2}$  mile post on Colombo-Kandy Road to the centre line of that road, thence northwards till it meets the starting point of the northern limit of the area.
