NATIONAL PRICES COMMISSION LAW, No. 42 OF 1975

- Order under Section 17

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the proviso to Section 17 of the National Prices Commission Law No. 42 of 1975, I, Mahadeva Ramalingam, Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do hereby order as follows:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Ayurvedic Drugs) Order No. 1 of 1976.
- (2) This Order shall apply to the whole of Sri Lanka.
- (3) The prices specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto, shall with immediate effect be the retail dealer's maximum retail price to any person above which Ayurvedic Drugs of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Column I of that Schedule shall not be sold.
- (4) Every trader or dealer who has for purposes of sale, any Ayurvedic Drugs of the description set out in Column I of the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the brand names of the Ayurvedic Drugs and in figures not less than one inch in height the maximum price of such Ayurvedic Drugs fixed by this Order so as the clearly seen by any customer.
- (5) Every person who sells any Ayurvedic Drugs of the description set out in Column I of the Schedule hereto by retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of lbs. of Ayurvedic Drugs sold; and
 - (c) the price charged for the number of lbs. of Ayurvedic Drugs sold.
- (6) Every person carrying on a business as a retail trader or dealer of Ayurvedic Drugs of the description specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto within the Municipal limits of Colombo Municipality shall furnish to me not later than 12 noon on 15th December, 1976. a return specifying—
 - (a) the stock of such Ayurvedic Drugs in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept;

and every person carrying on business as a retail trader or dealer of Ayurvedic Drugs of the description specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto, outside the Colombo Municipal limits shall furnish such a return to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th December, 1976.

(7) The maximum price specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container any, in which such Ayurvedic Drugs are sold.

Order under the Proviso to Section 17

Food Price Order No. C. 581.

AERATED WATERS

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the proviso to Section 17 of the National Prices Commission Law, No. 42 of 1975 I, Mahadeva Ramalingam. Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do hereby order as follows:—

- (1) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto to be the retail dealer's maximum retail price to a consumer above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in Column I of the Schedule shall not be sold within Sri Lanka;
 - (2) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other articles;
 - (3) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any articles specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a quantity of such article in a suitable container, with the maximum prices for such article fixed by this Order displayed in figures not less than one inch in height on price tags or boards attached to such container in such a manner that the article and the maximum prices could be clearly seen by any customer;

- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in Column I of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of such articles sold by (weight);
 - (v) the price paid for the quantity sold;
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by retail;
- (5) direct that when any article specified in Column I of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in Column II of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any in which such article is sold.

NATIONAL PRICES COMMISSION LAW, No. 42 OF 1975

Order under the Proviso to Section 17

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the proviso to Section 17 of the National Prices Commission Law, No. 42 of 1975, I, Mahadeva Ramalingam, Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles), do hereby order as follows:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Imported Cotton Sewing Thread) Order No. 1 of 1976.
- (2) This Oder shall apply to the whole of Sri Lanka.

- (6) Every person who sells any Imported Cotton Sewing Thread by wholesale or retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out-

 - (a) The date of the sale;(b) The description and the quantity sold; and(c) The price charged for the quantity sold.
- (7) Every person carrying on business as a wholesale or retail trader in any "Imported Cotton Sewing Thread" specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto within the Municipal limits of Colombo Municipality shall furnish to me not later than 12 noon on 15th December, 1976, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stock of such "Imported Cotton Sewing Thread" in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept; and
 - every person carrying on business as a wholesale or retail trader in any "Imported Cotton Sewing Thread" specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto, outside the Colombo Municipal limits, shall furnish such a return to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15th December, 1976;
- (8) The maximum price specified in Columns II and III of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container if any, in which such Imported Cotton Sewing Thread are sold.

- (3) The prices specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall with immediate effect be the retail dealer's maximum retail price to any person above which Bicycle Tyres and Tubes of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of that schedule shall not be sold.

- (5) Every person who sells any Bicycle Tyres and Tubes of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto by retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale:
 - (b) the description and the number of Bicycle Tyres and Tubes sold; and
 - (c) the price charged for the number of Bicycle Tyres and Tubes
- (6) Every person carrying on a business as a retail trader or dealer of Bicycle Tyres and Tubes of the description specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto within the Municipal Limits of Colombo Municipality shall furnish to me not later than 12 noon on 15.12.1976, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stock of suchin his possession or under his control at the time the return is made; and
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept;

and every person carrying on business as a retail trader or dealer of Bicycle Tyres and Tubes of the description specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, outside the Colombo Municipal Limits shall furnish such a return to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15.12.1976.

(7) the maximum price specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall include the price of the wrapper or container if any, in which such Bicycle Tyres and Tubes are sold.

NATIONAL PRICES COMMISSION LAW NO. 42 OF 1975

Order Under Section 17

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by the proviso to Section 17 of the National Prices Commission Law No. 42 of 1975, I, Mahadeva Ramalingam, Controller of Prices (Food and Miscellaneous Articles) do hereby order as follows:—

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Water Pumps) Order No. 1 of 1976
- (2) This Order shall apply to the whole of Sri Lanka.

- (3) The prices specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall with immediate effect be the retail dealer's maximum retail price to any person above which Water Pumps of the description set out in the corresponding entries in Column 1 of that schedule shall not be sold.
- (4) Every trader or dealer who has for purposes of sale, any Water Pumps of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the brand names of the Water Pumps and in figures not less than one inch in height the maximum price of such Water Pumps fixed by this Order so as to be clearly seen by any customer.
- (5) Every person who sells any Water Pumps of the description set out in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto by retail shall give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the description and the number of Water Pumps sold; and
 - (c) the price charged for the number of Water Pumps sold.
- (6) Every person carrying on a business as a retail trader or dealer of Water Pumps of the description specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto within the Municipal Limits of Colombo Municipality shall furnish to me not later than 12 noon on 15.12.1976, a return specifying—
 - (a) the stock of such Water Pumps in his possession or under his control at the time the return is made;
 - (b) each store or other place at which such stocks are kept;

and every person carrying on business as a retail trader or dealer of Water Pumps or the decription specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, outside the Colombo Municipal Limits shall furnish such a return to the Deputy Controller of Prices of the District in which the business is carried on not later than 12 noon on 15.12.76.

(7) The maximum price specified in Column 2 of the Schedule hereto shall include the price of wrapper or contain if any, in which such Water Pumps are sold.
