MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, May 11, 1900.

THE Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated May 5, 1900.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Chairman; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. A. Perry; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; and Mr. H. A. Jayawardena.

The Minutes of April 6, 1900, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of April 6, 1900, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, Major L. F. Knollys moved "that the Council place on record their sense of the loss sustained by the death of Mr. J. Caderaman, Councillor for the Kotahena Division."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried unanimously.

2. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of April 30, 1900, were laid before the Council:—

April 30, 1900.

(46) Tender for the lease of the boutique No. 60, St. John's road.

Resolved that the offer of Rs. 44 per mensem, from Badameya, be recommended to the Council.

(50) Further remarks from Auditor-General on query No. 841 for December, 1898 (expenditure).

Resolved that the Council be recommended to pass the amount of Rs. 3.62 charged to vote Miscellaneous.

(84) Letter No. 210 of April 4, 1900, from Superintendent of Works, suggesting to take steps to open the Bambalapitiya market.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to charge the following rents:—Rs. 10 per mensem for each meat stall, Rs. 3 per mensem for each fish stall, and Rs. 2 per mensem for each vegetable stall.

Resolved further, that notice be given under chapter XIX., 1, of the by-laws that the market will be open to the public on June 1, 1900.

Mr. James Peiris moved "that the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted."

Mr. H. A. Jayawardana seconded.—Carried unanimously.

3. A letter No. 31/5409 of April 5, 1900, from the Colonial Secretary, intimating that the cost of transferring the water mains and connections from the road in front of Uplands to the new road *via* Alutawata will be met by Government, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna moved "that the thanks of the Council be conveyed to Government for the concessions made in connection with this work."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

4. The Chairman's Administration Report for 1899 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to a Special Committee consisting of Dr. J. L. Vanderstraeten, Mr. Stanley Bois, Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. Arthur Alvis, and Mr. James Peiris — three to form a quorum."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

5. An application from Mr. A. Raffel, Cemetery-keeper, for extension of his leave from May 1 to May 6, 1900, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved that the application be allowed.

Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried unanimously.

6. An application from Mr. G. E. R. Goonawardena for one week's leave from April 21, 1900, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved that the leave applied for be granted.

Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried unanimously.

7. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to April 30, 1900, and Progress Report of Work done for April, 1900, were laid on the table.

8. The Auditor-General's report for 1899 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to the Special Committee appointed to consider the Chairman's Administration Report for 1899."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried unanimously.

9. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for December, 1899, were laid on the table.

10. The City Analyst's report on the town water for April, 1900, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

11. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder for April, 1900, were laid on the table.
