SIR,—IT is with the deepest regret that I have to communicate to you the melancholy intelligence of the death of His Royal Highness The Duke of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha, Duke of Edinburgh, K.G., second son of Her Majesty the Queen.

His Royal Highness expired at the Castle of Rosenau, near Coburg, at 10 o'clock in the evening on the 30th instant, to the great grief of Her Majesty and of all the Royal Family.
