<p>Preamble.</p> <p>Construction.</p> <p>Amendment of section 309 of principal Ordinance.</p> <p>Amendment of schedule II.</p>	<p>An Ordinance to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."</p> <p>WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance:" Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:</p> <p>1 This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.</p> <p>2 For sub-section (d) of section 309 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be substituted: The Governor may order a respite of the execution of the warrant or appoint some other time or other place for its execution.</p> <p>3 In the eighth column of schedule II. of the principal Ordinance the words "one hundred rupees" shall be substituted for the words "fifty rupees" as applying to section 368 of the Ceylon Penal Code.</p>
