#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

#### Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Tuesday, November 13, 1900.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 8, 1900. Present :---Mr. H. White, Acting Chairman ; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton ; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten ; Mr. Stanley Bois ; Mr. A. Forsyth ; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne ; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. Chas. Perera ; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of October 12, 1900, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,-That the Minutes of October 12, 1900, be confirmed.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy presented a memorial addressed to the Chairman and Councillors of the Municipal Council of Colombo from certain ratepayers of the city of Colombo relative to charges against a Member of Council, and praying that application be made to His Excellency the Governor to appoint a Commission of inquiry into these charges, and moved that it be read.
