MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Tuesday, November 13, 1900.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 8, 1900.

Present:—Mr. H. White, Acting Chairman; Mr. F. H. Grinlinton; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Stanley Bois; Mr. A. Forsyth; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of October 12, 1900, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of October 12, 1900, be confirmed.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy presented a memorial addressed to the Chairman and Councillors of the Municipal Council of Colombo from certain ratepayers of the city of Colombo relative to charges against a Member of Council, and praying that application be made to His Excellency the Governor to appoint a Commission of inquiry into these charges, and moved that it be read.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

The memorial was accordingly read.

1, 2, and 3. The following questions and motions standing in the name of Mr. James Peiris were, by leave of Council, postponed for next Meeting of Council:—

"(1) To ask the Chairman whether he has received any petitions or letters containing charges of corruption or misconduct against any Members of this Council or Officers of the Municipality, and to move for papers.

"(2) To move that this Council do request the Government to appoint a Commission to inquire into any charges of corruption or misconduct preferred against any Members of this Council or Officers of the Municipality."

"(3) To move that a Special Committee be appointed to draft rules defining the duties of the Standing Committee and the Executive Officers of the Council, and to suggest such amendments in the Municipal Councils' Ordinances as they may consider desirable for the more efficient administration of the Municipality."

4. Pursuant to notice Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved,—That the papers in connection with the cesspit in the house belonging to Mr. L. B. Fernando at Gintupitiya street be considered, and that resolutions be passed thereon.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.

The matter having been considered, the Chairman intimated that the estimate would be referred to the Manager of the Health Department for reconsideration.

5. The Supplemental Budget No. 2 of 1900 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved,—That the Supplemental Budget No. 2 of 1900 be sanctioned.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

6. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of October 26, 1900, was laid before the Council :—

October 26, 1900.

10. Further remarks from Auditor-General on quarry No. 340, for October, 1899 (expenditure). "The allowance paid to Nicholas Silva, Clerk and Accountant, Health Department, is from the lump vote of Rs. 58,980, 'Salaries, Wages, and Allowances, Health Department.' As this is a personal allowance, the authority of Council is necessary sanctioning the increase to this officer's salary."

Resolved,—That Council be recommended to sanction the expenditure of Rs. 60 to be charged against vote No. 98, being personal allowance to Clerk and Accountant, Health Department.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved,—That the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee of October 26, 1900, be adopted.

Mr. F. H. Grinlinton seconded.—Carried.

7. The following further interim report of the Special Committee dated October 31, 1900, appointed on July 13, 1900, to report upon the present system of removing nightsoil, to ascertain how far it can be more economically and efficiently worked, and what reductions, if any, can be made in the charge for conservancy and clearing of cesspits, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Committee recommends a further reduction of the charges in connection with the clearing of cesspits as follows :—

For a double bullock cart, from Rs. 3.25 to Rs. 3.

For a single bullock cart, from Rs. 2 to Re. 1.75, the actual amounts paid to the contractors.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved,—That the report of the Special Committee be adopted.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

8. A report of the Special Committee appointed on May 11, 1900, to consider the Chairman's Administration Report for 1899, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. P. Coomarasamy moved the adoption of this report, omitting the last sentence of the last paragraph.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved as an amendment,—That the report be adopted in its entirety.

A letter No. 78/01085 of September 19, 1900, from the Colonial Secretary, intimating that Government will convert into gravelled roads the reservations for roads about Havelock park, if the Municipality will thereafter take them over and keep in good order, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Resolved,—That the Chairman do address Government with a view to having the limits of the city extended in that direction.

11. A letter No. 85/013267 of October 9, 1900, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to acquisition of land opposite the Colpetty market to widen St. Michael's road, was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

Dr. Solomon Fernando moved,—That the consideration of the matter be deferred.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried.

12. Letters dated September 5 and 10, 1900, from the Superintendent of Works and the Sanitary Officer, respectively, reporting on the remedial measures necessary at the Fishers' quarters at Uplands, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved,—That a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. A. Perry, Mr. F. H. Grinlinton, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Major L. F. Knollys, and Dr. Solomon Fernando be appointed to report on the matter—three to form a quorum.
