Local Board, Negombo.**COMMUTATION TAX FOR 1901.**

NOTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, Negombo, that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 35 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1898, has imposed an annual tax, payable in six days' labour, upon all persons residing within the limits of the Local Board, who would have been liable, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, to the performance of labour of the maintenance

of the roads or other public means of communication by land or by water, if the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884 had not been passed.

Such labour may be commuted by a money payment of Rs. 2 in the town of Negombo and the island of Pitipana and Munnakkara and Re. 1.50 in the island of Duwa on or before March 31, 1901. After that date the payment will be Rs. 4 and Rs. 3 respectively per head.
