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ROAD COMMITTEE NOTICES.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Provincial Road Committee of the Province of Sabaragamuwa that the acreage of Oonankanda estate assessed on account of construction and upkeep of the Glenalla-Havilland Branch Road should be about 153 instead of 79 acres, and the Committee therefore, acting under the provisions of section 6 of the Ordinance No. 14 of 1896, will on Thursday, the 14th day of February, 1901, at 2.30 o'clock P.M., at their office in Ratnapura, proceed to alter and vary the limits of the district originally defined for the purposes of this Ordinance by adding the following acreage originally assessed for construction, repair, and upkeep of the said road, viz. :—

And whereas the said estate has become bound and liable under the provisions of the said Ordinance for payment of the additional moiety which it would have

been liable to pay had such additional acreage been originally included in the district for assessment of construction, and the Committee will in due course assess the proportion payable by the said estate as aforesaid, and acting under the provisions of sub-sections (a) and (b) of section 21 of the said Ordinance, divide the construction assessment money amongst the estates which have previously paid construction assessment in shares proportionate to the sums so previously paid by them, and retain the upkeep assessment money to be applied towards the future upkeep and repair of the said road.

And at the time and place aforesaid the Committee will take evidence, if necessary, and receive and consider objections and suggestions.

Ulapane-Nugawela Road.

NOTICE is hereby given that, in terms of section 11 of "The Branch Roads Ordinance, 1896," a general meeting of the proprietors or resident managers of estates interested in the construction of the Ulapane-Nugawela road, for which a vote of Rs. 35,910 has been passed by the Legislative Council, will be held at Denmark Bungalow, Ulapane, on Saturday, February 23, 1901, at 2.30 P.M., for the purpose of electing a Local Committee to perform the duties imposed upon such said Committee by the Ordinance.

- (5) The names of the proprietors, resident managers, or superintendents, and of the agents.

The general meeting for the election of the Local Committee must consist of such number of proprietors or resident managers within the district as shall represent not less than one-third of the acreage.
