MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, February 15, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated February 9, 1901.

Present :--- The Hon. Mr. F. R. Ellis, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. Stanley Bois; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaráswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. B. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of January 18 and 30, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Conncil, were taken as read.

Resolved,--That the Minutes of January 18 and 30, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice the Chairman moved—That the Government be asked to issue a Proclamation defining the limits of the Municipality in the wards in accordance with the draft now submitted to Council.

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Council resolved to go into Committee to consider the matter.

Limits of the Wards.

No. 2, Pettah Ward.—Resolved that the words "Kayman's gate" and "Gasworks street" be deleted and that the words "5th Cross street" be substituted therefor. No. 3, St. Sebastian Ward.—Resolved that the words "Gasworks street" be deleted and the words "5th

Cross street" be substituted therefor.

No. 7, Maradana Ward.—Resolved that the words "and turning southwards along the Yakbadde road" be deleted and the words "bridge over the water-course beyond the 4th milestone" be substituted therefor.

Resolved also that the word "Institute" before the word "Bacteriological" be substituted for "Institution" wherever occurring.

Council having resumed, the Chairman moved-That the Proclamation as amended in Committee be approved.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.-Carried.

2. The Supplemental Budget No. 1 of 1901 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved-That the Supplemental Budget No. 1 of 1901 be sanctioned.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded .-- Carried.
