## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

#### Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on January 19, 1901, at 1.30 p.m.

Present:—The Chairman; Dr. W. G. Keith; E. Venning, Esq.; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; D. G. Goonewardene, Esq.; Dr. E. Ludovici; and C. P. Hayley, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of last Meeting.

2. Pursuant to notice Dr. Anthonisz asked—When the bridge on the Hirimbure road is to be properly repaired, as it has been unsafe for a considerable period and materials for the construction were collected by the side of the road and left there ever so long. Who is to blame for this?

The Chairman replied that one of the abutments of the bridge has to be rebuilt, and this work can only be undertaken during dry weather, when the water is low. The work will be commenced on the 1st proximo.

3. Pursuant to notice Dr. Anthonisz asked—Has it come to the knowledge of the Chairman that gambling is carried on within the Municipality and on the public roads? As gambling leads to crime, steps ought to be taken to prevent it.

The Chairman replied that his attention had not been drawn to this. He has referred the matter to the Superintendent of Police for report and will give orders to the Police.

4. Pursuant to notice Dr. Anthonisz asked—The Council being informed by the authorities that the reconstruction of the Mahamodara bridge will be taken in hand this year, has the work commenced, or when will it begin?

The Chairman replied that he was sorry he was unable to give any satisfactory information. The Director of Public Works in a report to Government, dated June 9, 1900, stated that "indents have been sent for the iron works required for the reconstruction of the Mahamodara and Bentota bridges, and the work will be carried out as the iron arrives. I hope the whole three bridges—Bentota, Mahamodara, and Gintota—will be completed next year."

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Pursuant to notice Mr. C. P. Hayley moved-That a sum of 5 cents be charged to all persons entering the Pavilion ; that annual tickets be sold admitting holders at all times, except when the Pavilion is closed to the public for any special function at the cost of Rs. 5, and that they be not transferable. Members of any club paying rent for the use of the Pavilion to be exempted from payment of the above fee.

Seconded by Mr. E. Venning.

Mr. D. G. Goonewardene moved as an amendment-That a responsible officer be appointed to look after the building and prevent the commission of nuisances, and that the proposed charge be not levied.

Seconded by Dr. E. Ludovici.

The Chairman suggested that the consideration of the matter be deferred to the next Meeting, which was agreed to.

6. The proposed scheme for opening roads and alleys in the Fort was brought up for reconsideration, when it was proposed by the Chairman-That Messrs. Hayley and Ludovici be appointed to assess the properties which it is proposed to acquire.

Seconded by Mr. D. G. Goonewardene,-Carried.

7. Submitted proposed Ordinance to impose a general tax on dogs, forwarded to the Council for any comments and suggestions which it may desire to make, and letter No. 1/0312 from the Colonial Secretary, dated 16th instant, intimating that the dog tax within the Galle Municipality has been raised to Re. 1.

8. Submitted applications for the post of Auditor.

It was unanimously resolved to submit the name of Mr. E. Soerisz to His Excellency the Governor for nomination by him as Auditor for the year 1901, in terms of section 116 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance.

9. An appraisement report of land at Talbot town proposed to be acquired for erecting model cottages was laid on the table.

10. In terms of section 88 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance the Council proceeded to elect by ballot five of their number to form a Standing Committee. The result of the balloting was the election of the following :-Mr. D. G. Goonewardene, the Colonial Surgeon, Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, Dr. E. Ludovici, and Mr. C. P. Hayley.

#### COLOMBO MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS by section 212, sub-section (2), of "The Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 1887," it is enacted that the Chairman of the Municipal Council may by public notice prohibit the washing of clothes in any public place not set apart therefor as in sub-section (1) of the said section is provided :

I, Arthur Sampson Pagden, the Chairman of the Municipal Council of Colombo, do by this public notice prohibit the washing of clothes in the following public place which has not been so set apart, that is to say :--

Pond near junction of Wall's lane and Blomendahl road adjoining premises No. 11, Blomendahl road, on the west side of Blomendahl road.

Any person who washes clothes contrary to the foregoing prohibition will be guilty of an offence, and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty Rupees.
