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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on March 23, 1901, at 1.30 p.m.

*Present:*—The Chairman; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; Dr. W. G. Keith; Dr. E. Ludovici; D. G. Goonewardene, Esq.; N. Dias Abeyesinha, Esq.; F. Abeyesundere, Esq.; and Magdoon Ismail, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of last Meeting.

2. Pursuant to notice Dr. Ludovici asked—Whether permission of the Council was obtained to make a golf link in close proximity to the public tennis court at the Victoria park.

The Chairman replied that he is unable to find that permission was granted. There are no papers on the subject.

3. Pursuant to notice Dr. Anthonisz moved—That as on sanitary grounds a solid road is preferable to a porous one; and as the estimated expenditure for the canal embankment, the hurdles on the esplanade, and one-half of the annual cost of the upkeep of roads are considered by the Council not advisable to be expended for the purchase of a steam roller, that permission be obtained from Government to take the cost of a steam roller from the Government loan of Rs. 60,000 granted for sanitary purposes.

Seconded by Dr. E. Ludovici.

After a prolonged discussion, in which the mover of the resolution, the Chairman, and Mr. D. G. Goonewardene took part, the motion was put to the vote, with the following result:—

The Chairman declared the motion lost.

4. Pursuant to notice the Chairman moved—That the proposal of T. Arolis of Bussa to withdraw the case against the Government Agent for recovery of one-tenth of the purchase amount of the Gintota toll, on condition that the amount be refunded to him, be accepted, each party bearing his own cost.

Seconded by Mr. F. Abeyesundere.—Carried.

5. The question of charging a fee for entrance into the Pavilion, as proposed by Mr. C. P. Hayley in his motion made at Meeting of Council held on January 19 last, was brought up for reconsideration, when it was resolved that in the absence of the mover the matter be allowed to drop.

6. Submitted letter from Mr. A. R. Ephraums, dated February 28, 1901, complaining that the Sanitary Officer neglects to pay a debt due to him.

Moved by Mr. N. Dias Abeyesinha—That Mr. Ephraums' letter be referred to the Sanitary Officer for his explanation.

Seconded by Mr. Magdoon Ismail.—Carried.
