MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Wednesday, April 17, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated April 11, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Acting Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraeten; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. P. D. Warren; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. James Peiris; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; and Dr. Solomon Fernando.

The Minutes of March 15, 1901, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of March 15, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. H. Morgan asked if the attention of the Chairman has been called to the judgment of the Additional District Judge of Colombo in the case *Ameresekere vs. the Municipal Council*, and the strictures passed therein on actions of the Council through its officers, and moved that a Committee be appointed to inquire into and report upon the alleged irregularities, and what officers (if any) are responsible therefor.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.

By leave of Council Mr. R. H. Morgan withdrew his motion.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. H. Morgan presented two petitions from Almina Perera of 104, Kollupitiya, and Angeltina Perera of 105, Kollupitiya, praying for permission to re-thatch their dwelling-houses, and moved that the petitions be read and considered.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.

The petitions were taken as read.

This motion was by leave of Council withdrawn (the Chairman undertaking to visit the spot with Mr. R. H. Morgan and the Superintendent of Works).

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. James Peiris asked what steps have been taken to give effect to the recommendations made in the report of the Committee appointed to inquire into the working of the Health Department, and moved for papers.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.

The Chairman stated that steps would be taken to give effect to the recommendations as far as is practicable, and that there were no papers.

4. The following extract from the Minutes of the Standing Committee of April 10, 1901, was laid before the Council:—

April 10, 1901.

(9) Application dated February 25, 1901, from Thagis, Peon, for a gratuity.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to grant a gratuity of Rs. 50 to Peon Thagis.

Mr. R. H. Morgan moved—That the recommendation contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

5. A report of the Special Committee dated February 26, 1901, re-appointed on January 18, 1901, to inquire into and report on the matter of widening and extending Colpetty lane and the lane on the northern side of Wellawatta police station, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the matter do lie over pending a return of revenue and special expenditure on the different wards being furnished.

6. An interim report dated April 11, 1901, of the Special Committee appointed to consider, *inter alia*, rules in connection with tramways (Colonial Secretary's letter No. 13/2188 of February 8, 1901) was laid before the Council.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved—That the report be adopted.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.

7. The following draft regulation proposed to be substituted for regulation No. 43 of the regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council under authority of section 34 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1886, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* of February 24, 1899, was laid before the Council.

Regulation No. 43 of the regulations made by the Governor in Executive Council under authority of section 34, sub-section (c), of Ordinance No. 7 of 1886, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 5,602 of February 24, 1899, is hereby repealed and the following regulation substituted therefor :—

43. The value of the amount of water consumed during the quarter shall be ascertained and calculated in accordance with the foregoing regulations, and no deduction shall be made for any portion of the supply except in such cases as the premises are entirely occupied for private residential purposes. In all such cases, in which the whole of the water supplied is measured by meter, a deduction of five gallons per mensem for each rupee the premises are assessed at per annum shall be made from the quantity as ascertained in accordance with the foregoing regulations.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the Chairman do communicate with the Government on the subject with a view to an amendment of the regulation in order that the rebate be allowed.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried.

8. Papers in connection with the appointment of a successor to Mr. W. M. F. Wijeyeratne, late Head Overseer, Works Department, were submitted to Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That all the papers be circulated, and that the matter be brought up before next Meeting of Council.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

9. Auditor-General's further remark on query No. 72 on the accounts of the Works Department for February, 1900, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the papers be circulated among the Members of the Standing Committee.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

10. A memorandum by the Chairman with reference to judgment of the Supreme Court in Municipal Court case No. 4,569 for obstruction at Nos. 23 and 24, St. John's street, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the papers be circulated.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

11. An application from the Sanitary Officer for three months' full pay leave was laid before the Council.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved—That the application be allowed on the distinct understanding that the Sanitary Officer's annual report now overdue is submitted when he resumes duties.

Mr. P. D. Warren seconded.—Carried.

12. Papers relating to land required for widening Malay street were laid on the table.

13. Papers with reference to a design of flag for the Town Hall were laid before the Council.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved—That a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Major L. F. Knollys, and Mr. P. D. Warren be appointed to report on the matter.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

14. Papers with reference to the proposed establishment of a fire brigade were laid before the Council.

Mr. R. H. Morgan moved—That the amount of the estimate be provided in the next Supplemental Budget.

Mr. P. D. Warren seconded.—Carried.

It was resolved further that the Chairman be authorized to telegraph to Messrs. Shand, Mason & Co. of London for the fire engine and appliances after consultation with the Inspector-General of Police.

15. Papers with reference to the proposed site at the Racquet Court for the Pettah Library were laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That Government be asked to favourably consider the application of the Pettah Library Committee for a site in the Racquet Court for the Library.

Mr. R. H. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

16. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to March 31, 1901, and Progress Report of Work done for March, 1901, were laid on the table.

17. Sanitary Officer's report for 4th quarter of 1900 was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

18. An application from Mr. H. L. Ameresekera, a clerk in the Municipal Court, for an extension of his leave till the end of April, 1901, was allowed.

19. Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for November, 1900, were laid on the table.

20. City Analyst's report on the town water for March, 1901, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

21. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder for April, 1901, were laid on the table.
