## **NOTICES UNDER THE WASTE LANDS ORDINANCES**

[Notice under "The Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897, 1899, and 1900."]

**T**AKE notice, that unless within three months from the 1st day of April, 1901, the persons if any, who claim any interest in the lands hereinafter mentioned, appear before the Government Agent of the Central Province at the Kandy Kachchani and make claim to the said lands or to some interest therein :

Such Government Agent, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by Ordinance No. 1 of 1897, will declare by writing under his hand that the said lands as to which no claim has been made, are the property of the Crown.

*Description of Lands referred to.*

Two pieces of land adjoining each other called or known as Upasakayekanda, described as lot No. 7,535 in preliminary plan No. 2,337, situate in the villages called Telihunna and Polmalagama and Upasakayekanda, described as lot No. 7,536 in preliminary plan No. 2,337, and situate in the villages Hatagama, Tembiligala, and Telihunna, both in Ganga Ihala korale, Udapalata, in the District of Kandy, Central Province; containing in extent 59 acres and 2 roods and 152 acres 3 roods 30 perches, respectively; and bounded as follows: on the north by lot No. 7,537 known as Upasakayekanda claimed by the Crown, lot No. D 256 in preliminary plan No. 2,327 called Parahinna claimed by Mr. J. Wells, and lot No. 13 in preliminary plan No. IX. called Belungalehenamukalana situate in the village Hatagama, lands described in title plans Nos. 44,410 and 52,037 called Kehelwatta claimed by Mr. John Clovis de Silva, and Crown land known as Pinnagollemeda and Godapaddewagura; on the east by the land called Richmond Hill claimed by Mr. W. A. 
