DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to validate certain proceedings of the Legislative Council.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Governor of the island of Ceylon on or about the 13th day of June, 1900, provisionally appointed William Henry Jackson, Esquire, Ceylon Civil Service, provisionally to be a nominated official member of the Legislative Council of the said island:

And whereas the said William Henry Jackson acted under the authority of the said appointment as such nominated official member of the said Council and took part in the proceedings thereof from the date of the said appointment to the 27th day of November, 1900:

And whereas doubts have arisen as to the validity of the said appointment, and it is expedient to legalize the votes given by the said William Henry Jackson as such official member, and to validate the proceedings of the said Council during the period aforesaid: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Votes and proceedings of council validated. 1 The votes given by the said William Henry Jackson as nominated official member of the Legislative Council, and all proceedings of the Legislative Council of Ceylon from the 13th day of June, 1900, to the 27th day of November, 1900, are hereby declared to be valid and effectual to all intents and purposes as if the said William Henry Jackson had been duly appointed and admitted a member of the said Council during the period aforesaid.
