An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884."

WEST RIDGEWAY.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884," be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

To be read as one with Ordinance No. 32 of 1884.

1 This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884," hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance."

Section 6 of Ordinance No. 32 of 1884 amended.

2 For section 6 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:

Such notes shall be called "currency notes," and shall be payable only at the office of the commissioners in Colombo. The holders of currency notes shall be entitled to obtain on demand at the said office in exchange for

such notes coin which may at the option of the commissioners be either silver rupees of India or gold coin, which is legal tender in this colony under any Order of His Majesty the King in Council, but no other coin.

Section 11 amended.

3. To section 11 of the principal Ordinance shall be added the following words "or in gold coin, which is legal tender in this colony under any Order of His Majesty the King in Council."

Section 12 amended.

4. In section 12 of the principal Ordinance the words "or in gold coin, which is legal tender in this colony under any Order of His Majesty the King in Council," shall be inserted immediately after the word "coin."

Section 14 amended.

5. In section 14 of the principal Ordinance the word "silver" shall be repealed.

Section 16 amended.

6. In section 16 of the principal Ordinance the word "silver" shall be repealed.

Section 20 amended.

7. In section 20 of the principal Ordinance the words "and gold" shall be inserted immediately after the word "silver."
