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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, May 17, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated May 11, 1901.

*Present* :—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Acting Chairman; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of April 17 and May 1, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of April 17 and May 1, 1901, be confirmed.

1. The following extracts from Minutes of the Standing Committee of May 10, 1901, were laid before the Council :—

*May 10, 1901.*

- (13) Chairman's memorandum dated April 16, 1901, with regard to the Floral Hall at the Racquet court. Resolved the Committee recommends that the building be sold as it stands, the purchaser to remove the materials and level the ground within six weeks of acceptance of offer.
- (14) Memorandum by the Chairman dated April 20 and 23, 1901, with reference to night soil carts with connected papers. Resolved that the papers be circulated, and Rs. 4,000 recommended to be transferred from vote for new carts to vote for repairs to carts, and a further provision of Rs. 5,000 made for repairs to cover the estimate of Superintendent of Works.
- (18) Estimate for drainage of a section of Kollupitiya road through the approach road to the Kollupitiya railway station, Rs. 7,340. Resolved that the Committee recommend that the Council should undertake the work, and that the estimate be circulated with full particulars.
- (25) Remarks by Auditor-General on queries Nos. 433, 434, 438, and 454 on the accounts of Secretary's Department for September, 1900 (revenue). Laid on the table. (Query No. 434 to be laid before Council.)
- (26) Remarks by Auditor-General on queries Nos. 263, 264, 266, 271, and 272 on the accounts of Health Department for June, 1900 (expenditure). Resolved that the charges in Nos. 263, 264, and 266 be recommended to be passed.
- (56) Chairman's memorandum dated May 6, 1901, with regard to claim for interest by Gas Company. Recommended that the Gas Company's offer be accepted.

(57) Letter from J. H. P. Walker applying for remuneration for doing the work of the late assistant commutation clerk in addition to his own duties.

Approved that he receives half pay of assistant commutation clerk in addition to his own.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved—That the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee, except item No. 25, be adopted.

Mr. Chas. Perera seconded.—Carried.

With reference to item No. 25, Mr. Chas. Perera moved—That all questions with regard to the removal of any gas or electric lampposts be dealt with by the Standing Committee.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

2. An interim report of the Special Committee appointed on January 18, 1901, to consider the question of filling up the vacancy caused by Mr. M. Cochran's retirement, was laid before the Council.

Mr. Arthur Alvis moved that the report be adopted.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

3. Memorandum by the Chairman with reference to the judgment of the Supreme Court in Municipal Court case No. 4,569, instituted for obstruction at Nos. 23 and 24, St. John's street, was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved—That the memorandum be adopted, and that notice do issue under chapter XVII. (1) of Ordinance No. 16 of 1881, now incorporated with No. 7 of 1887, to the defendant in the case to produce his title deeds with a view to further action.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

4. A letter No. 1,787 of May 7, 1901, from the General Manager, Ceylon Government Railways, requesting payment of the sum of Rs. 250 on account of the maintenance of the level crossing at Dematagoda for 1901, was laid before the Council.

Mr. Chas. Perera moved—That the amount be paid, and that it be provided in the Supplementary Budget; and further that the Chairman do ascertain from Government whether it is intended to retain the present watcher and gates; and that if Government agrees to retain them, the offer contained in Colonial Secretary's letter No. 76 of September 14, 1900, be accepted.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.—Carried.

5. An application from the President, Young Men's Christian Association, for the site of the Floral Hall on which to build headquarters for the Association was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten moved that the application be granted.

Mr. Chas. Perera seconded.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved—That a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. P. D. Warren, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Mr. Chas. Perera, and the mover be appointed to report—three to form a quorum—

- (1) Whether there is any necessity for the appointment.
- (2) To define duties of the Head Overseer.
- (3) To recommend a person if necessary.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.—Carried.

7. The Auditor-General's remarks on judgment in case instituted by Cuttilan & Co. against the Municipal Council were laid on the table.

8. Opinion of the Council's lawyers on the question of giving the Health Department work on contract was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated.

9. A petition from K. K. Thangam and Muna Moulattamby, stall-holders of Gintupitiya mutton market, praying that they may be allowed to sell offal in stall No. 4, now vacant in the market, was laid before the Council.

Mr. Chas. Perera moved that the application be allowed, provided there is no applicant to sell mutton.

Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten seconded.—Carried.

10. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to April 30, 1901, and Progress Report of Work done for April, 1901, were laid on the table.

11. Auditor-General's report for 1900 was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
