MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

COLOMBO MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, June 14, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated June 8, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. Chas. P. Dias; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. H. A. Jayewardene; Dr. Solomon Fernando; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of May 17, 1901, having been printed, and copies thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of May 17, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. H. A. Jayewardene moved that the Superintendent of Works be requested to furnish an estimate for the construction of a side drain from 131A., Layard's Broadway, downwards, and moved for papers.

This motion was by leave of Council amended as follows:—That the Superintendent of Works be asked to furnish an estimate for drainage of Layard's Broadway.

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. P. Dias and carried.

2. The following extracts from Minutes of the Standing Committee of May 31, 1901, were laid before the Council:—

May 31, 1901.

- (3) Memorandum dated May 18, 1901, from Chairman, with reference to extension of Slave Island Market. The Committee approves the Superintendent of Work's estimate for Rs. 200 for converting the surplus meat stalls into fish stalls, and recommends it to Council.
- (4) Chairman's memorandum dated May 18, 1901, with reference to dépôt cattle sheds. Approved. To be recommended to Council and Rs. 8,400 to be provided.
- (8) Papers with reference to cheap Season Tickets to travel on the Railways. Committee approve of paying difference for 3rd class tickets, Chairman to ascertain cost. (Cost as ascertained Rs. 427.44).
- (10) Memorandum dated May 20, 1901, from Secretary, applying for a Supplementary Vote of Rs. 60 on account of Inspector's uniform. Approved.
- (11) Application from the Assistant Municipal Engineer for further travelling allowance. Approved. Rs. 200 at Rs. 25 per mensem from May 1 to December, 1901.

- (12) Letter No. 382 of May 20, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to Havelock Town park.
Resolved that a notice be published in the papers about the opening of the park.
- (15) Letter from M. Selliah stating that he has purchased from the owners the theatre shed at Price park, and offering to pay Rs. 1,200 as ground rent for one year.
The Committee approves a monthly tenancy rent payable in advance. Chairman to settle amount of rent.
Rent Rs. 150 per mensem.
- (16) Papers with reference to extending water supply.
Chairman to go over each ward with the member and decide what extensions are most necessary.
- (17) Letter No. 64 of April 19, 1901, from Auditor-General, informing of the delay in furnishing certified copies of estimates for 1900, and Mr. Solomonsz's explanation thereon.
Allowed an extra clerk for three months at Rs. 30 a month to bring up arrears.
- (21) Memorandum from Secretary for authority to purchase photographs of the Town Hall decorations.
Recommended the expenditure Rs. 84 to Council.
- (22) Memorandum dated May 23, 1901, from Secretary, applying for an additional vote of Rs. 500 on account of cost in legal proceedings.
Approved. A book to be kept as an index for reference to such opinions.
- (28) Estimate for coir dust shed for Glenie street latrine, Rs. 94.
Approved.
- (29) Estimate for the proposed gateway at the Borella cemetery, Rs. 10,122.
Approved. To be recommended to Council.
- (36) Estimate for paving and cementing a main drain near Santiago street, Rs. 93.
Approved.
- (71) Estimate for repair of Hendala jetty, Rs. 81.26.
Approved.
- (79) Papers with reference to leasing the Racquet Court for grazing cattle.
Times for grazing should be fixed when considering the question of leasing the land in future.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne moved—That the recommendations contained in items 3 and 4 of the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

With reference to item 16 of the foregoing Minutes Mr. Arthur Alwis moved—That a sum of Rs. 20,000 be voted in order to lay larger water mains in the Fort.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper seconded.—Carried.

With reference to item 29 of the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee, Dr. Vanderstraaten moved—That the recommendation contained therein be adopted.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved as an amendment—That a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. A. Perry, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Major L. F. Knollys, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, and Mr. Arthur Alwis—three members to form a quorum—be appointed to go into the question of providing shelter at or near the Borella Cemetery.

Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten withdrew his motion and seconded that of Mr. P. Coomaraswamy which was carried.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the recommendations contained in items 8, 10, 11, 12, 15, 17, 21, 22, 28, 36, 71, and 79 of the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee be adopted.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

3. A report dated May 28, 1901, of the Special Committee appointed on May 17, 1901, (1) to report whether there is any necessity for the appointment of a successor to Mr. W. M. F. Wijeyaratna, late Head Overseer, Works Department; (2) to define duties of the Head Overseer; (3) to recommend a person, if necessary, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Arthur Alwis moved the adoption of the report.

Mr. H. A. Jayawardene seconded.—Carried.

4. A report dated June 6, 1901, of the Special Committee appointed to ascertain the cause of the water of the Colombo lake being so low, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved the adoption of the report.

Mr. Arthur Alwis seconded.

Major L. F. Knollys moved as an amendment—That the report be adopted with the exception of the last paragraph.

The Hon. Mr. Cooper seconded.

Whereupon the amendment was carried.

5. An interim report dated June 7, 1901, of the Special Committee appointed to inquire and report *inter alia* upon the steps to be taken to facilitate the obtaining of metal, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Arthur Alwis moved the adoption of the report omitting the last paragraph.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

6. A letter No. 38 of May 31, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of correspondence with the Secretary of State regarding the drainage and water supply of Colombo, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved—(1) That the Hon. the Colonial Secretary be respectfully requested to convey to His Excellency the Governor the Council's appreciation of his efforts to subserve its best interests and its deep and grateful sense of the obligation under which His Excellency has placed it; (2) that a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. A. Perry, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, Mr. R. H. Morgan, and Mr. Arthur Alwis—three members to form a quorum—be appointed to consider the proposals contained in the Colonial Secretary's letter and connected papers.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

7. A letter dated May 15, 1901, from Messrs. Boustead Brothers, with reference to resolution of Council of May 1, 1901, regarding the so-called agreement for arc lighting of Tramway routes, was laid before the Council with connected papers, having been previously circulated.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That Messrs. Boustead Brothers be referred to the Chairman's last letter, No. 681 of May 8, 1901, and that they be informed that the Council regret that they are unable to take over and pay for the materials or to pay for telegrams or other expenses.

Dr. Solomon Fernando seconded.—Carried.

8. A letter dated May 21, 1901, from Mr. A. Philip, stating that no formal minute has been recorded by the Municipal Council of the acceptance and opening for the use of the public of the George Wall Memorial Fountain, was laid before the Council, having been previously circulated with connected papers.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That referring to Mr. Philip's letter of May 21, the Council accept with thanks the George Wall Memorial Fountain, and declare it open for the use of the public.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

9. A letter from Mr. R. Paulusz, Assistant to the Sanitary Officer, applying for a conveyance allowance, together with the recommendation of the Special Committee on the question of filling up the vacancy caused by Mr. Cochran's retirement, was laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That the recommendation of the Special Committee be adopted, and that the allowance of Rs. 35 per month be paid.

Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

10. The Chairman's Administration Report for 1900, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved—That a Special Committee consisting of Mr. A. Perry, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Major L. F. Knollys, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, Mr. C. P. Dias, Mr. Arthur Alvis, and Mr. H. A. Jayawardene—three members to form a quorum—be appointed to consider the report.

Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen seconded.—Carried.

11. Auditor-General's further remarks on the inspection of books for 1900, with reference to certain irrecoverable taxes on vehicles and animals due for first half-year of 1899, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That authority of the Council be granted to strike off as irrecoverable the taxes referred to.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

12. Auditor-General's further remarks on the inspection of books for 1900, with reference to outstanding bills on vehicles and animals tax for 1897, 1898, and first half-year of 1899, returned as irrecoverable, also bills on dog tax for 1897 and 1898, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That authority of the Council be granted to strike off the bills in question as irrecoverable.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

13. Auditor-General's further remarks on query No 376 on the expenditure accounts of the Health Department for November, 1899, with reference to charges amounting to Rs. 15.40 and Rs. 8.10 paid to K. D. Cornelis, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That authority of the Council be granted to pass the charges referred to.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

14. Auditor-General's further remarks on queries Nos. 446, 447, and 454, with reference to irrecoverable stall rents of Edinburgh Meat Market Rs. 15 and Fruit and Flower Market Rs. 25 for September, 1900, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That authority of Council be granted to strike off the stall rents in question as irrecoverable.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

15. Auditor-General's remarks on query No. 116 on the expenditure accounts of the Health Department for April, 1899, with reference to bonus of Rs. 380 paid to Kuppen Kangany, were laid before the Council.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy moved—That authority of the Council be granted to pass the bonus referred to.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

16. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1, to May 31, 1901, and Progress Report of Work done for May, 1901, were laid on the table.

17. Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for January, 1901, were laid on the table.

18. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder, were laid on the table.
