MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on June 15, 1901, at 1.30 p.m.

Present :—The Chairman; H. A. Grant, Esq.; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; N. Dias Abeyesinhe, Esq.; Dr. E. Ludovici; F. Abeyesundere, Esq.; and Magdon Ismail, Esq.

1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on May 11 last.

2. Dr. Anthonisz asked—If the drains in the bazaar, a very crowded locality, could not be better flushed than done at present?

The Chairman replied that with the view of improving the flushing of the bazaar drains he has ordered a pump for the well from which water is drawn for flushing purposes.

3. Dr. Anthonisz asked—If drains in the bazaar, to prevent sweeping and other refuse being thrown into them, could not be covered with movable boards to be properly flushed and to allow sufficient space on the boards for people to stand upon?

The Chairman replied that the question had been once before asked and a reply given.

4. Dr. Anthonisz asked—The hackery and cart stands in the bazaar after a shower of rain is in a filthy state with mud containing the urine and dung of cattle, and if it could not be paved with rough slabs of granite so that it could be flushed, allowing the water to flow into the drain across the triangle?

The Chairman replied that the cart stand could be paved, and he thought it desirable that it should be. He will call for an estimate of the cost.

5. Dr. Anthonisz moved—That the Director of Public Works be kindly informed that the Municipal Council has been intimated that the repairs of the Mahamodara bridge will be undertaken this year, and that five months have elapsed and the work has not commenced as yet.

Seconded by Mr. F. Abeyesundere.

Resolved—That the reply of the Provincial Engineer, Southern Province, to an inquiry made by the Chairman, to the effect that so far as he knew, the work will be completed this year, be considered satisfactorily.

6. Dr. Anthonisz moved—As was the case before, the road repairs within the Municipality be given out in future on contract to save delay and lessen the labour of keeping a check-roll by the Superintendent of Works, which interferes with his other duties.

Seconded by Mr. H. A. Grant.

On the suggestion of the Chairman the motion was withdrawn ; the question to be brought up before the Standing Committee.

7. The Chairman moved—That the by-laws appearing in the draft Ordinance published in the *Government Gazette* of March 11, 1900, with the additional by-laws since added thereto in the annexed printed copy, be now submitted to the Governor in Executive Council for approval and confirmation, in terms of Ordinance No. 8 of 1901, section 6.

Seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abeyesinhe.

The Council resolved itself into a Committee and discussed the additional by-laws *seriatim*.

The Council resumed.

Resolved—That the additional by-laws be adopted with the omission of the words “and tickets” in line 3 of by-law, chapter VII., 21, and that application be made to the Governor in Executive Council, as moved by the Chairman and seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abeyesinhe.

8. Dr. E. Ludovici moved—That the playing of golf in the esplanade outside the Fort be restricted to the mornings, in view of the numerous accidents that have occurred from the indiscriminate playing of golf at inconvenient hours.

Seconded by Dr. P. D. Anthonisz.

The Chairman declared the motion carried.

9. Dr. Ludovici amended the motion, notice of which he had given, and moved—That the Council request Government to empower the Government Agent to acquire sufficient land to construct an alley through the Fort market premises to serve houses Nos. 10, 11, and 12, Lighthouse street, in carrying out the dry-earth system.

Seconded by Dr. Anthonisz.—Carried.

10. Mr. C. P. Hayley moved—That the Public Works Department be instructed to remove the unsightly building they have erected on the rampart close to the Anthonisz clock tower.

Seconded by Dr. Ludovici.

After discussion the motion was put in the following amended form :—“That the Chairman be requested to take such steps as he may deem desirable to effect the removal of the unsightly building erected by the Public Works Department on the ramparts close to the Anthonisz clock tower.”

Carried.

Resolved—That the Government Agent be requested to stay the construction of the building.

Resolved—That the contractor to the Public Works Department, who is erecting the building, be called upon to show cause why he should not be punished for commencing to erect the building without giving notice to the Chairman, as required by section 29 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896.

11. Submitted Chairman's Administration Report for 1900.

Ordered that the report be circulated among the Members of Council.

12. Submitted a report that certain houses in the Fort being provided with back or side entrances afford facilities for working their latrines on the dry-earth system. The houses are the following :—

Leyn Baan street, Nos. 10, 14, 17, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26	Middle street, No. 1

Resolved—That the Chairman be empowered to notice the owners of these houses requiring them to close the cesspools in their houses and to substitute a dry-earth closet therefor, in terms of section 33 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1896.

13. Submitted letter from the Honorary Secretary, Galle Reading Room, complaining that caterpillars abound in the suriya trees on the side of the Reading Room and cause much inconvenience to the Members, and requesting that the trees may be cut down.

Resolved—That the Secretary of the Reading Room be asked to inform the Council whether this is the general wish of the Members, and that the matter be brought up for consideration at the next Meeting of Council.

14. Submitted the following recommendation from the Standing Committee :—“Recommended that an additional bullock cart be provided to remove night soil from the public latrines.”

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, July 12, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated July 6, 1901.

The Minutes of June 14, 1901, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of June 14, 1901, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Mr. C. P. Dias moved—That this Council do take steps to remove, or at least mitigate, the nuisance caused by the increase of lake flies to an unusual extent near the Pettah railway station and the north-eastern border of the Colombo lake.

This motion was by leave of Council amended as follows:—That this Council do take steps to remove, or at least mitigate, the nuisance caused by the increase of lake flies to an unusual extent near the Pettah railway station and the north-eastern border of the Colombo lake, and that the matter be referred to Mr. Green, the Entomologist, for report.

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. C. Perera and carried.

Resolved unanimously that the Committee censure the conduct of both of these officers for their neglect of duty, in not promptly reporting to the Chairman the occurrence of the outbreak.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the report be adopted subject to satisfactory replies being received to the letter No. 71 of June 26, 1901, to the Colonial Secretary.

Mr. H. A. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried unanimously.

5. A report of the Special Committee appointed to report on all questions connected with lighting and draft gas contract were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved—That Council do go into Committee.

Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten seconded.

[Council in Committee.]

Resolved—That the words "gas and incandescent gas" in line 4 of clause (2) be deleted, and that the words "and maintained" be added after the word "supplied" in the last line.

Resolved—That the words "the aforesaid" in the first line of clause (4) be deleted and word "all" substituted therefor, and that the word "shall" be substituted for the word "to" and the word "all" for "the" in the last line, omit the word "or" in last line.

In clause (5) add the words "for each burner" after the word "candles" in line 6.

In clause (15) substitute "light" for words "candle power" in line 14.

In clause (27) omit the words "by memorial" in line 2.

The Council having resumed, Mr. C. Perera moved—That the contract be adopted as amended, and that the Chairman be authorized to complete it.

Mr. James Peiris seconded.—Carried.

6. The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved the adoption of the report amended as follows:—The Committee report that they are unable to find any suitable site for a Recreation Ground, and would suggest that the question do lie over pending the acquisition by Government of the Elie House grounds for a reservoir, or at such other time as the Council may consider desirable.

Mr. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

8. A letter No. 45/08075 of June 19, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of Ordinance No. 8 of 1901, intituled "An Ordinance to further amend the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, 1887," and inviting the Chairman's attention to section 7 thereof, was laid on the table.

9. A letter No. 54/09561 of July 1, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to level crossing on the North and South Base Line road, was laid on the table.

10. A letter No. 56/11671 of July 2, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the gate which is being erected across the end of Commissariat street, in order to enclose that street within the Customs premises, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the matter be deferred till next Meeting of Council, and that in the meantime the papers be circulated.

Major L. F. Knollys seconded.—Carried.
