# MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Municipal Office on Friday, August 9, 1901.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated August 3, 1901.

Present:—Mr. A. S. Pagden, Chairman; Mr. A. Perry; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; Mr. D. W. H. Skrine; Mr. Chas. Perera; Mr. Chas. P. Das; Mr. R. H. Morgan; and Mr. M. L. M. Zainudeen.

The Minutes of July 12, 1901, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of July 12, 1901, be confirmed.

- 1. The following extracts from Minutes of the Standing Committee of July 23 and August 2, 1901, were laid before the Council:--
  - July 23, 1901.
  - (4) Letter No. 552 of June 28, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to the materials of the Floral Hall.
    Approved the Superintendent of Works' proposal: the cost of the firewood, Rs. 167, to be charged to the steam rollers and the firewood issued to them.

(7) Papers with reference to supervision of dairies outside the Municipal limits. Resolved that the rates proposed by the Government Agent be approved.

(10) Letter No. 249 of July 1, 1901, from Government Veterinary Surgeon, with reference to rinderpest at night soil depôt.
The Committee recommend that the claim of Rs. 74 for expenses be paid.

(12) Letter No. 529 of June 24, 1901, from Superintendent of Works, with reference to the estimate for paving footway, Dean's road.

Resolved that the estimate for Rs. 1,820 be approved for concrete paving.

Papers with reference to the purchase of an iron safe. Resolved that the estimate of Rs. 300 for purchase of a new safe be passed. Chairman will submit proposals for dealing with old safe. The question of weekly payments to coolies to stand over. (20) Papers with reference to taxes on "Bishop Gate" and the lawyer's letters.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to strike off the amount due as irrecoverable.

(22) Draft rules in connection with clearing of cesspit privies by private persons licensed under Municipal by-laws. Approved.

(23) Cost of frames to put up notices relating to licensed guides, Rs. 292 50.

Approved, if the Chairman thinks it necessary

(24) Estimate for iron pontoon for dredger, Rs. 5,117.

The Committee wish the Council to consider whether the lake should be retained in the Council's charge or Government requested to take it over. If it is to be retained, the Committee recommend the estimates for the pontoon and steady boat.

(25) Estimate for steady boat, Rs. 4,312. The Committee wish the Council to consider whether the lake should be retained in the Council's charge or Government requested to take it over. If it is to be retained, the Committee recommend the estimates for the pontoon and steady boat.

(27) Estimate for repairs to cattle sheds, night soil depôt, Kanatta, Rs. 145.

(30) Resolved estimate for repair of Edinburgh meat market, Rs. 425.

Approved.

(31) Estimate for cast iron seats, Havelock Town park, Rs. 482.

Approved. (32) Estimate for rebuilding culvert in 3rd Division, Maradana, near the Lady Havelock Hospital, Rs. 259. Approved.

(33) Estimate for covering over a public drain through No. 16, Union place, Rs. 161. Approved, provided the covering is put on in a manner to allow the drain to be kept clean. (40) Replies from persons who were asked to value properties in connection with objections to assessment. Resolved that the Chairman be authorized to pay the rates asked by Mr. Koelman, when he is employed to value in cases of objections to assessments

(71) Estimate for repairing a block of depôt cooly lines for coolies, Dematagoda slaughter-house, Rs. 44.

Approved.

(74) Papers with reference to gratuity to Bastian Appu, caulker. Recommended to be paid to his widow.

(75) Papers with reference to planting grass over the land used at the night soil depôt at Narahenpitiya. Chairman to settle. Committee approve of the necessary expenditure.

#### August 2, 1901.

(3) Letter No. 53/010408 of July 1, 1901, from Colonial Secretary, with reference to draft Ordinance for a general tax on dogs. Resolved that the Council should be consulted as to the amount of the tax. The Committee note that the new Ordinance gives the Chairman power to make by-laws.

(7) Papers relating to fees for inspection of imported frozen meat.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to compromise with the Cold Storage Company and

accept a sum of half cent a pound for the inspection of frozen meat.

(15) Estimate for erecting and thatching fourteen cattle sheds at night soil depôt, Kanatta, Rs. 675. Approved. Chairman will ascertain from Veterinary Surgeon and Superintendent of Works what materials can be used from the old sheds. (16) Estimate for paving North and South Base Line road level crossing, Rs. 200.

Approved.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That Council do go into Committee. The Hon. Mr. F. H. Cooper seconded.

#### [Council in Committee.]

Mr. C. Perera moved-That Council do resume.

The Hon. Mr. F. H. Cooper seconded. Council having resumed, Mr. C. Perera moved—That the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee of July 23, 1901, be adopted, except items Nos. 24 and 25, and that those two recommendations be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. D. W. H. Skrine, Mr. C. Perera, and Mr. R. H. Morgan—three to form a quorum—for report..

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the recommendations contained in the foregoing Minutes of the Standing Committee of August 2, 1901, be adopted, and that the words "and that Government be asked that the proper authority referred to in the Ordinance be defined to be the Council instead of the Chairman" be added to item No. 3, and also that the words "the arrangement not to be retrospective" be added to item No. 7.

Mr. A de A Senevirates seconded—Corried

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna seconded.—Carried.

2. A report of the Special Committee appointed to report on all questions connected with lighting and draft contract for extension of gas was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved—The Council do go into Committee.

Mr. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.

### [Council in Committee.]

Resolved,—That in clause 4 of the draft contract, line 3 of paragraph 5, the word "and" be deleted and the words "and fixed" be added after the word "entered."

Resolved,—That in the specification attached to the contract the words "person or persons" be substituted for the word "contractor" in line 7 of clause 8.

Resolved,—That in clause 11 the words "shall provide all fencing, hoardings, lights, and other protection necessary for the public safety and" be added after the word "contractors" in line 1.

Resolved,—That the words "plant and appliances" be added after the word "materials" in line 2

of clause 14.

Resolved,—That the words "and in accordance with the term of this contract" be added after the word "manner" in last line of clause 16, and that the word "and" in line 3, paragraph 3, of clause 17 be deleted and the words "and fixed" be inserted after the word "erected."

Resolved,—That in section A the words "and fittings" be added after the word "tubes" in line 10, that the words "all mains and services" be substituted for the words "the main on level ground" in line 17, and that the words "of nine feet" be added after the word "length" in line 18.

Section B.—In line 1, paragraph 1, the words "those services to" to be deleted and the word "shall" be substituted therefor.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved—That Council do resume.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.

Council having resumed, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved - That the gas contract as amended be adopted, and that the Chairman be authorized to complete it.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved—That the report be adopted.

Mr. A. Perry seconded.—Carried.

4. A letter No. 56/11671 of July 2, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the gate which is being erected across the end of Commissariat street in order to enclose that street within the Custom premises, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved—That the Council concurs in the proposal made by the Government.

Mr. A. Perry seconded.—Carried.

A letter No. 64/13713 dated July 30, 1901, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to drainage and

water supply of Colombo, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved—That the letter be referred to a Special Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. A. Perry, Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten, Mr. A. de A. Seneviratna, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, Mr. D. W. H. Skrine, Mr. Chas. Perera, Mr. P. Coomaraswamy, Mr. R. H. Morgan, and Mr. Arthur Alvis for report—three to form a quorum.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

6. A memorandum dated July 3, 1901, by the Chairman, with reference to rebate on water supplied by meter

was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved—That the amended regulation be passed and sent to Government for approval in place of that adopted on April 17, 1901.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper seconded.—Carried.

- 7. Auditor-General's further remarks on query No. 421 on expenditure accounts of August, 1901, were laid before the Council.
  - Mr. C. Perera moved—That authority be granted to pass the items.

Mr. A. Perry seconded.—Carried.

- 8. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to July 31, 1901, and Progress Report of Work done for July, 1901, were laid on the table.
- 9. Sanitary Officer's report for first quarter, 1901, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
  - 10. Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for March and April, 1901, were laid on the table.
- 11. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder, were laid on the table.
- 12. An annual report of the Sanitary Officer for 1900 was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 13. An application from Messrs. Shipley & Co. for license to establish a mutton stall in Park street was laid before the Council.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall, Kandy, on Saturday, July 20, 1901, at 8.30 o'clock a.m., in accordance with notice dated July 16, 1901.

Present:—Hon. Mr. H. Wace, Chairman; W. D. Gibbon, Esq.; C. Vanderwall, Esq.; R. W. Jonklass, Esq.; L. Creasy, Esq.; P. T. Habeeboo Lebbe, Esq.

- 1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on June 29, 1901, were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.
- 2. The following documents were submitted:—Statements of Receipts and Expenditure from close of 1900 to June 30, 1901, on account of the Municipal Fund, comprising the (No. 1) General Revenue, (No. 2) Consolidated Rate (Police and Lighting), and (No. 3) Water-rate Accounts; Progress Report of Work done brought up to the same date; Health Officer's Report for, and Statement of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during, the month of June.

Resolved,—That the several statements, together with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, No. 7 of 1887, and the Health Officer's report, be forwarded to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the Government Gazette.

3. The following papers were laid on the table:

(1) Reports by the several Inspectors on laundries inspected during June and register. Return of burials in the General Cemetery during the first six months of the year.

(3) Report by the Auditor for second quarter of 1901.
