MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on August 24, 1901, at 1.30 p.m.

Present:—The Chairman; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, C.M.G.; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; N. Dias Abeyesinha, Esq. D. G. Goonawardena, Esq.; Dr. E. Ludovici; F. Abeyesundera, Esq.; and Magdon Ismail, Esq.

- 1. Read and confirmed Minutes of Meeting held on July 27 last.
- 2. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz asked-That a few cocoanut trees in China Garden be removed to admit light and air in that locality, which is very damp, and that openings be made from the lanes in Havelock place to the Rope walk.

The Chairman promised to make inquiries as to the possibility of carrying out the proposal.

3. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz asked-That seats in the park be renewed as some have disappeared, and that slabs of granite or granite supports be made, as they are more durable than boards.

The Chairman replied he had no objection to the proposal, and promised to call for an estimate of cost.

- 4. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. P. Hayley moved That steps be taken to obtain control of all the lands within Municipal limits, especially such portions which are still under control of the Military Authorities.

 Seconded by Mr. N. Dias Abeyesinha.—Carried.
- 5. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz moved-That the Colonial Surgeon be kindly requested to state whether he can conveniently inspect the sanitation of the Municipality, if a carriage be allowed for the purpose. Seconded by Dr. Ludovici.—Carried.
- 6. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz moved—That the Civil Engineer be kindly requested to inspect the works carried out by the Municipal Superintendent of Works once a quarter or when most convenient to that officer, and that a carriage hire be allowed for that purpose, and the Superintendent of Municipal Works be directed to accompany that officer on his inspection.

The Chairman stated that the Provincial Engineer had written to say that he could not undertake the work of

inspection.

Dr. Anthonisz then withdrew the motion.

7. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Anthonisz moved—That Inspectors attending to sanitary duties be placed under

the orders of the Sanitary Officer, who ought to be held responsible for the san itation of the town.

Dr. Anthonisz withdrew the motion on the Chairman informing him that the Inspectors were under the orders of the Sanitary Officer.

8. Pursuant to notice, Dr. Ludovici moved—That the letter from the Secretary of the Golf Club be read and considered.

Seconded by Mr. D. G. Goonawardena.-Carried.

The letter was accordingly read, and the subject-matter discussed.

The following resolution was then passed, moved by Dr. Ludovici seconded by Mr. D. G. Goonewardena, and

carried, Mr. C. P. Hayley dissenting:—

That the original resolution be adhered to, and any concessions asked for by the Golf Club be then considered by the Council.

- 9. Submitted the following recommendations from the Standing Committee:—Recommended that a transfer of Rs. 370 be made from the head "Minor Works" to head "Contingencies" in the Budget to meet the cost of a typewriter and plans of the Municipal limits and Fort of Galle. Resolved, -That the transfer be approved.
- 10. Submitted a petition dated August 9, 1901, from the renter of the fish markets praying for a reduction of the rent.

Resolved,—That the application be disallowed. His case will be considered at the close of his rent.

- 11. Read letter No. 242 dated August 16, 1901, from the Surveyor General, intimating that he had selected a site on the ramparts for the erection of a meteorological shed and asking approval of Council. Resolved,-That the Council has no objection to the erection of the shed on the site indicated.
- 12. Submitted estimate for widening the cross road from the Colombo road to Templer road. Moved by Mr. D. G. Goonewardena, seconded by Dr. Ludovici, and carried—That the estimate be approved, and the Superintendent of Works directed to carry on the work.
